Today – Areas of heavy rain between Playa del Carmen and Tulum will continue to drift northward and bring periods of rain and perhaps an isolated storm to the course over the next couple of hours. Expect activity to become more scattered by mid-morning through the early afternoon hours before becoming likely once again late this afternoon and into this evening. Embedded thunderstorm potential will slowly rise this afternoon with the heating of the day. The temperature will reach a high near 81 degrees.

Additional rainfall through 6pm: 0.75" – 1.25", locally higher in heavy downpours or thunderstorms.

Extended forecast – Unsettled weather is expected to continue through Monday morning due to a frontal boundary positioned north of the Yucatán Peninsula. Expect intermittent waves of moderate to heavy rain and scattered embedded thunderstorms followed by multiple hours of dry conditions over the next couple of days. Precipitation chances will be highest during the late afternoon through overnight/early morning hours each day. Some scattered showers will remain possible through the early afternoon on Monday as the boundary works through the area before dry conditions become likely for the late afternoon and evening. Dry conditions are forecast on Tuesday.
