**Today** – Lower overall instability limited the coverage of last night's showers, storms, and resultant cloud cover into this morning. Expect an isolated potential for a pop-up or ocean shower this morning, with a scattered coverage of showers forecast to materialize this afternoon with the heating of the day. An isolated thunderstorm cannot be ruled out this afternoon. The temperature will top out in the low 80s. Winds will be rather light throughout the day.

**Rainfall through 5pm: 0.15" – 0.30", locally higher possible in any downpours or thunderstorms.**

**Rainfall 5pm Saturday – 7am Sunday: 0.50" – 1.00", locally higher possible in any downpours or thunderstorms.**

**Tomorrow** – Areas of rain and a few embedded thunderstorms are expected to occur overnight into daybreak Sunday, with locally heavy rain possible. After a likely lull from mid-morning to noon, expect a band of rain and possible storms to develop overhead in the early afternoon along a sea breeze boundary. Shower and storm chances should begin to wane by late afternoon and into the evening as the sea breeze moves inland and generates numerous showers and scattered storms across interior portions of the Yucatán Peninsula ahead of the front.

**Rainfall 4am Sunday to 5pm Sunday: 0.75" – 1.25", locally higher possible in any thunderstorms.**
