Today – Moisture and instability levels will increase throughout the day ahead of a cold front currently positioned over the western Gulf of Mexico. Expect a scattered coverage of showers and perhaps an isolated thunderstorm to develop this morning, with precipitation becoming more widespread this afternoon in addition to a scattered threat for thunderstorms. Additional waves of rain and thunderstorms are expected to develop overnight. Easterly wind gusts of 20-25 mph are expected along the ocean holes.

Rainfall through 6pm: 0.50" – 1.00", locally higher in heavy downpours or any thunderstorms.

Extended forecast – A cold front approaching the Yucatán Peninsula will bring unsettled weather to the area through Monday morning when the slow-moving boundary finally pushes through the region. Expect intermittent waves of moderate to heavy rain and scattered embedded thunderstorms followed by multiple hours of dry conditions over the next few days. Precipitation chances will be highest during the late afternoon through overnight/early morning hours each day. Some scattered showers will remain possible through the early afternoon on Monday morning before dry conditions become likely for the late afternoon and evening. Dry conditions are forecast on Tuesday.
