Extended forecast – A cold front approaching the Yucatán Peninsula on Thursday will bring unsettled weather to the area through late Saturday afternoon when the boundary finally pushes through the region. Expect intermittent waves of moderate to heavy rain and scattered embedded thunderstorms followed by multiple hours of dry conditions over the next few days. Precipitation chances will be highest during the late afternoon through overnight/early morning hours each day. A few lingering showers will remain possible Sunday morning before dry conditions become likely for Sunday afternoon. Dry conditions are forecast to continue on Monday.
