There will also be a low threat for a shower/T-storm after 2pm with a front approaching the region. Overall, coverage of any activity should remain spotty, at worst. Temperatures will reach the lower 90s this afternoon. **Peak Heat Indices: 95-100F. Sunrise: 6:15am / Sunset: 8:31pm**

Extended Forecast – The threat for a shower/T-storm could persist tonight with an upper-level disturbance and associated cold front approaching. The much higher threat for showers/T-storms likely develops late Saturday afternoon and into Saturday evening. The 6pm-12am Saturday evening timeframe will feature the highest chances for precipitation. There remains uncertainty on Sunday regarding precipitation chances, however with enough lingering moisture and instability, at least a low chance for a shower/T-storm seems reasonable at this time.
