**Today** – An area of low pressure situated just offshore will slowly shift away from the South Carolina coastline as the day progresses. The threat for rain showers will be highest this morning, especially between 7-9am. The threat for lightning is low but heavy downpours are possible in showers. Dry conditions are favored this afternoon as the focus for showers/T-storms shifts into southeast Georgia and coastal areas of South Carolina. Most likely rainfall: Less than 0.25". **Sunrise: 6:15am / Sunset: 8:32pm**

**Tomorrow** – A more typical sea breeze pattern will return to the area on Monday. Given the light flow the sea breeze should have an easy time developing and advancing inland during the afternoon. An isolated shower/T-storm could develop along the boundary; however chances will be capped at 15%. Afternoon temperatures should climb towards 90 degrees with light winds in place. **Sunrise: 6:15am / Sunset: 8:32pm**
