An isolated shower may develop well inland this afternoon, but most of the area will remain dry today.

Monday's Forecast – Patchy fog will be possible around daybreak that should burn-off by mid-morning. Otherwise, partly cloudy skies can be expected with highs near 80 degrees. An approaching cold front will likely stall across South-Central Florida by evening. This may produce an isolated shower during the evening hours, but the higher chances of seeing showers should stay north of Naples.
