Paul Casey

Paul Casey is set to make his sixth start at the RBC Heritage, missing the cut in each of his last two starts at Harbour Town Golf Links (2016 & 2018). Casey has qualified for the TOUR Championship in five of the last six PGA TOUR seasons.

Fasts Facts on Paul Casey:

- **0** Has not started the RBC Heritage with a round par or better in five previous starts, most starts in an event without an opening round par or better in his PGA TOUR career
- Six consecutive top-30 finishes on the PGA TOUR, marks the first time since the 2016-17 season where Paul Casey had a streak of six or more consecutive top-30 finishes
- Paul Casey is one of 11 players who have improved by 29 or more strokes from Round 1 to Round 2 at this event since 1983
