Things to Know

- Joaquin Niemann and Tom Lewis (-10) share the 36-hole lead at the Rocket Mortgage Classic
- Neither co-leader has made a bogey through 36 holes
- Phil Mickelson plays the final two holes in 1-under to make the cut on the number in his tournament debut
- Defending champion Bryson DeChambeau misses the cut for the second time this season and first since The Genesis Invitational
- 2021 Masters Tournament champion Hideki Matsuyama was forced to withdraw before the start of his round after testing positive for COVID-19

- One of two players in the field with no bogeys through 36 holes (other: Tom Lewis)
- Finished T5 at the 2019 Rocket Mortgage Classic, his only prior start at the event
- Entered the week in the top 30 of the FedExCup standings (25) and Official World Golf Ranking (30)
- Two runner-up finishes this season (P2/Sentry Tournament of Champions, T2/Sony Open in Hawaii)
- Lone career PGA TOUR title came at A Military Tribute at The Greenbrier in 2019

Tom Lewis (T1/-10)

- First 36-hole lead/co-lead of his PGA TOUR career
- Previous-best 36-hole position on TOUR: T4/2021 AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am
- Ties the lowest 36-hole score of his PGA TOUR career (134)
- Third career 36-hole score of 134, with two coming in his last two starts (134/2020 Shriners Hospitals for Children Open, 134/2021 Travelers Championship, 134/2021 Rocket Mortgage Classic)
- One of two players in the field with no bogeys through 36 holes (other: Joaquin Niemann)
- Best finish on TOUR to date: T2, 2020 World Golf Championships-FedEx St. Jude Invitational (career-low 61 in R3)

Additional Player Notes

- Troy Merritt (T3/-9) hit all 14 fairways for the second time in a round on the PGA TOUR (first: R2/2017 The RSM Classic)
- **Chris Kirk** is in the top three after the second round of the Rocket Mortgage Classic for the second consecutive year; Kirk held a share of the 36-hole lead in 2020 before finishing T21
- Max Homa (T3/-9) closed with four consecutive birdies to record a 7-under 65, tying his lowest score of the season (fourth instance and first since R3/The American Express)
- Sean O'Hair (T6/-8) is making last start on his Major Medical Extension
 - o 197.519 300 points (solo-2nd, 2-way T2, or 3-way T2): remains in the Major Medical category for the remainder of the season
 - 109.972 197.518 points (solo-5th to 4-way T2): moves into the 126-150 in previous season's FedExCup standings category
 - o Fewer than 109.972 points: Moves to No. 5 in the Reorder category
- 18-hole leader **Davis Thompson** fails to record a birdie in the second round (1-over 73) following a first-round 63; enters the third-round T6 at 8-under in his seventh career PGA TOUR start and third as a professional
- In his debut at the Rocket Mortgage Classic, 45-time PGA TOUR winner **Phil Mickelson** plays the final two holes in 1-under to make the cut on the number; Mickelson was second in the field in the second round in Strokes Gained: Off the Tee (1.551)
- Willie Mack III, a native of Flint, Michigan, makes the cut for the first time in his third start on the PGA TOUR; Mack, who made the cut on the number, missed the cut earlier this season at the Farmers Insurance Open and The Genesis Invitational
- Defending champion **Bryson DeChambeau** (72-71/-1) misses the cut for the second time this season and first since The Genesis Invitational; marks the eighth missed cut by a defending champion on TOUR during the 2020-21 season (most recent: Max Homa, Wells Fargo Championship)
- 2021 Masters Tournament champion Hideki Matsuyama was forced to withdraw before the start of his round after testing positive for COVID-19; Matsuyama recorded a 2-under 70 in the first round to stand T56
