Today – A cooler and much drier airmass has spread across Lower Michigan with brisk northerly winds in place. Gusts of 20-25 mph will be possible with strongest winds occurring between 10am-2pm. There is just enough lingering moisture to promote widespread cloud development by the late morning hours. These clouds might even be able to squeeze out some sprinkles or a light shower, mainly between 12-4pm. Temperatures today likely only reach the middle 70s. **Sunrise: 5:59am / Sunset: 9:13pm**

Extended Forecast – The main concerns this weekend revolve around precipitation chances and the increasingly warm and humid conditions that return to the area. The first period of concern will be late Saturday into Saturday night when a warm front pushes across the region. The second period of concern is late Sunday afternoon when lake breeze boundaries could allow for isolated development. Given the uncertainty, rain chances have been capped at 10% but may need to be increased, especially late Sunday. Highs will be in the lower 80s on Saturday and then warming to near 90 degrees on Sunday. Winds should generally hold under 15 mph this weekend.
