#### FINAL First-Round Notes – Friday, September 11, 2020

Thursday Weather: Due to fog, the start to round one was delayed one hour and began at 8 a.m. Cloudy, with a high of 69. Wind SSW 5-10 mph. Due to darkness, round one was suspended for the day at 7:11 p.m., with 13 players yet to complete their first rounds.

Friday Weather: Partly cloudy and foggy, with a high of 55. Winds light and variable. First round resumed at 7:28 a.m. and was completed at 8:08 a.m.

## Things to Know

- On Thursday, the first round was suspended for the day due to darkness at 7:11 p.m., with the 13 players who failed to complete their rounds back in position Friday at 7:28 a.m. The round was completed at 8:08 a.m.
- The Safeway Open marks the first of 50 events in the 2020-21 PGA TOUR Season; with the exception of 2019, has opened each season since the TOUR went to a wraparound schedule in 2013
- On the strength over seven birdies and one eagle, Russell Knox opens with a bogey-free 9-under 63; sinks 107'4" of putts
- Cameron Percy opens with a bogey-free 8-under 64 a year after finishing T7 at the Safeway Open
- Highlighted by seven birdies and an eagle, Sam Burns opens with 64 in his second Safeway Open start
- 2016-17 Safeway Open champion Brendan Steele opens with bogey-free 7-under 65 in his 10<sup>th</sup> tournament start; is the only player to successfully defend a Safeway Open title
- In his seventh professional PGA TOUR start, and eighth overall, Akshay Bhatia opens with 6-under 66
- Most recent of three players to convert an 18-hole lead into victory at the Safeway Open was Brendan Steele in 2017

## Russell Knox (63/-9)

- Opens with a bogey-free 9-under 63, one stroke shy of his career-low on the PGA TOUR (R4/2014 BMW Championship)
- Made seven birdies and one eagle (par-5 fifth)
- Only previous 18-hole lead/co-lead came at the 2013 AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am (T1); finished T28
- Marks the Safeway Open's lowest opening-round score since Scott Piercy posted a 10-under 62 in 2016
- Making his sixth start in the Safeway Open; best showing of T9 came in his first start of 2012
- Seeks his third career PGA TOUR title and first since the 2016 Travelers Championship
- Finished outside the top-125 in the FedExCup last season (No. 127) for the first time since 2013

#### Sam Burns (64/-8)

- Made an eagle at the par-5 16<sup>th</sup> and seven birdies including four in a row on Nos. 9-12 to open with an 8-under 64
- In only previous Safeway Open start, posted scores of 72-74—146 to miss the cut in 2018
- Best of five top-25 finishes last season was a T6 at The American Express in Palm Springs; advanced to the FedExCup
   Playoffs for a second-consecutive year before ending his season at No. 111 in the FedExCup
- Best of 60 PGA TOUR starts is T3 from the 2018 Sanderson Farms Championship

## Cameron Percy (64/-8)

- Australia native birdied his last three holes (Nos. 16-18) to open with a bogey-free 8-under 64
- Comes off a T7 finish in last year's Safeway Open, his lone top-10 finish of the season
- Seeks his first career PGA TOUR victory in his 154<sup>th</sup> start this week
- Best finish on TOUR is a P2 at the 2010 Shriners Hospitals for Children Open in his first season on TOUR
- Winner of the 2014 Price Cutter Charity Championship on the Korn Ferry Tour
- Winner of five events on PGA TOUR of Australasia

#### Brendan Steele (65/-7)

- Made seven birdies and no bogeys en route to a 7-under 65 in his 10<sup>th</sup> Safeway Open start
- As the event's 2016-17 winner, remains the only player to defend a Safeway Open title (dating to 2007)
- Was five strokes off the lead after 18 holes in 2016 and T1 after the first round in 2017
- Comes off a 2019-20 PGA TOUR Season highlighted by three top-10 finishes and a 47<sup>th</sup> place finish in the FedExCup; only higher finish was when he finished 33<sup>rd</sup> in 2017
- Prior to his two Safeway Open titles, first won on the PGA TOUR at the 2011 Valero Texas Open

## Akshay Bhatia (66/-6)

- Offset eight birdies with two bogeys to open with a 6-under 66 in his eighth PGA TOUR start and seventh as a professional
- Despite under-par opening-round scores in his first six professional TOUR starts, has yet to make a cut
- Wake Forest, N.C. resident made first professional TOUR start at age 17 (2019 Sanderson Farms Championship)
- Runner-up at 2018 U.S. Junior Amateur
- At 17, became the youngest player to be named to the United States Walker Cup team (on the winning 2019 team)

# **Miscellaneous Notes**

- **Bo Hoag** made eight birdies, including one from 26'8" on his last hole of the day (No. 9), to post a bogey-free 8-under 64; falls one stroke shy of his career-low on the PGA TOUR
- Pat Perez posted a bogey-free 7-under 65, his lowest score on the PGA TOUR since posting the same number in round two of the 2019 Mayakoba Golf Classic
- Making his third career PGA TOUR start, and second as a professional, 22-year-old Monday qualifier Andy Zhang hit all 18
  greens in regulation en route to a bogey-free 6-under 66. In his only other professional start, the former University of
  Florida Gator finished T23 at the 2019 Houston Open
- In his sixth Safeway Open start and first PGA TOUR since winning the Charles Schwab Series at Ozarks National in his PGA TOUR Champions debut, **Phil Mickelson** opened with a 1-under 71; marks his fifth score over 70 in 17 rounds in the event
- **Jim Furyk**, who also won in his PGA TOUR Champions debut earlier this season, posted an even-par 72 a year after finishing T17 at Silverado in his first tournament start
- Notables PGA TOUR veterans making their first Safeway Open start: Sergio Garcia (72), Shane Lowry (68)
- Bo Van Pelt withdrew prior to his tee time (family reasons) and was replaced in the field by Parker McLachlin (78)
