Things to Know

- Keegan Bradley holds 36-hole lead/co-lead for sixth time on TOUR in search of first win since 2018 BMW Championship
- Two 36-hole leaders/co-leaders have gone on to win the Sanderson Farms Championship since the event moved to the
 Country Club of Jackson in 2014 (Ryan Armour/2017, Cameron Champ/2018); Hudson Swafford is the only 36-hole leader
 co-leader to go on to win this season, at last week's Corales Puntacana Resort & Club Championship
- Monday qualifier MJ Daffue follows first-round 65 with 3-under 69 to sit fourth at 10-under
- Three of the four Monday qualifiers advanced to the weekend (MJ Daffue/4th, Steve Lewton/T45, Jay McLuen/ T45)
- Three of the four first-round co-leaders record scores of even-par or higher in round two
- Former Stanford standout Patrick Rodgers makes his first hole-in-one on TOUR

Keegan Bradley (1st/-13)

- Follows first-round 66 with 7-under 65, including two stretches of three birdies in a row (Nos. 1-3 and Nos. 13-15), for low
 round of the day and two-stroke lead while making first appearance at the Sanderson Farms Championship
- Holds 36-hole lead/co-lead for sixth time on TOUR, converting one of previous five for victory (2011 PGA Championship);
 most recent 36-hole lead/co-lead was 2019 Arnold Palmer Invitational presented by Mastercard (T46)
- Ranks No. 2 in Strokes Gained: Putting this week (6.629)
- Missed the cut in both events he has played this season (Safeway Open, U.S. Open)
- Seeks first victory since 2018 BMW Championship, one of his four PGA TOUR titles (2011 AT&T Byron Nelson, 2011 PGA Championship, 2012 World Golf Championships-FedEx St. Jude Invitational)
- WGC win at Firestone CC is the lone title he won without requiring a playoff

J. T. Poston (T2/-11)

- Lone bogey through 36 holes came at his opening hole Friday (No. 1) before reeling off six birdies, including five in a six-hole stretch (Nos. 10-15)
- Advanced to the weekend in all five starts at the Sanderson Farms Championship (T29/2016, T53/2017, T54/2018, T11/2019)
- Missed the cut at the U.S. Open (71-82) in his only other start this season
- Lone PGA TOUR win came at the 2019 Wyndham Championship, going bogey-free en route to victory, the first player to achieve that feat since 1974 (Lee Trevino/Zurich Classic of New Orleans)

Charley Hoffman (T2/-11)

- Recorded most birdies of any player through 36 holes (16)
- Needed just 54 putts through 36 holes; holed 152' 8" of putts in round two compared to 82' 9" in round one (total 235' 5")
- Only one of four first-round leaders/co-leaders to post a score in the 60s in round two
- Extends his streak of par-or-better rounds this season to a perfect 10-for-10
- Making his fifth start at the Sanderson Farms Championship with a T22 in 2007 at Annandale Golf Club his best showing
- Seeks his fifth TOUR title and first since the 2016 Valero Texas Open

MJ Daffue (duffy) (4th/-10)

- 31-year-old native of South Africa mixes five birdies with two bogeys en route to second consecutive round in the 60s
- Shot 69 in the Monday qualifier at Deerfield GC before advancing in an 8-for-2 playoff en route to his fifth TOUR start
- Previous four starts came in 2020, two where he Monday qualified, two where he accepted sponsor exemptions; T52/2020
 Puerto Rico Open (SE), T22/Workday Charity Open (MQ), MC/2020 Barracuda Championship (SE), 72nd/2020 Safeway Open (MQ)
- Last Monday qualifier to win on TOUR; Corey Conners/2019 Valero Texas Open
- Recorded three rounds of 65 in 13 rounds on TOUR, including Thursday's opening-round 65
- Ranks No. 2 in Strokes Gained: Approach The Green (4.861)
- Former Lamar University golfer notched three top-25s in nine starts on the Korn Ferry Tour in 2019
- Posted a T73 result at the 2020 Panama Championship on the Korn Ferry Tour
- Currently ranked No. 861 in the Official World Golf Ranking

Miscellaneous Notes

- Denny McCarthy (T5/-9) has posted par-or-better scores in 11 of 12 rounds at the Country Club of Jackson (74/R1/2017)
- **Kristoffer Ventura** (T5/-9) has posted par-or-better scores in all 10 rounds he has played this season; finished T7 at Safeway Open and T52 at Corales Puntacana Resort & Club Championship
- Sergio Garcia (T7/-8) ranks No. 1 in Strokes Gained: Off The Tee (3.768) and No. 1 in Driving Distance (307.4)
- 2015 Sanderson Farms Championship winner Peter Malnati sits T12 at 7-under after a second-round 67
- In his first start of the season after missing the U.S. Open due to a positive coronavirus test, 2019-20 PGA TOUR Rookie of the Year Scottie Scheffler (T35/-4) bogeyed final hole en route to 5-under 67, jumping from T106 after round one
- Three of the four first-round co-leaders posted second-round scores in the 70s; **Kevin Chappell** (72/T7/-8), **Sebastian Munoz** (73/T12/-7), **Jimmy Walker** (77/T45/-3)
- Coming off 13 top-20 finishes in 13 starts on the Korn Ferry Tour and PGA TOUR combined, including back-to-back top-10s this season at the U.S. Open (T6) and Corales Puntacana Resort & Club Championship (T8), **Will Zalatoris** missed the cut with 73-71
- Hattiesburg, MS native Davis Riley (MC/+1) missed the cut in his second Sanderson Farms Championship (T39/2019)
- Patrick Rodgers (MC/-1) posted his first hole-in-one on TOUR, holing a 9-iron from 147 yards at No. 13. It marks the sixth ace since 2014 when the Country Club of Jackson began hosting the tournament
