Things to Know

- The last three 54-hole leaders/co-leaders of the Sanderson Farms Championship have converted for the win
- The Sanderson Farms Championship has produced a first-time winner each year since 2014 (six seasons)
- Seeking his first PGA TOUR title, Cameron Davis birdies his first five holes en route to a career-low 63
- In search of his first PGA TOUR win since the 2017 Masters Tournament, Sergio Garcia posts a bogey-free 66
- J.T. Poston takes his first-ever 54-hole lead/co-lead on the PGA TOUR
- Sebastian Munoz is 9-under 207 in bid to become the first to successfully defend a Sanderson Farms Championship title

Cameron Davis (T1/-14)

- Australian followed birdies on his first five holes with an eagle-3 at No. 14 en route to a career-low 63 (previously 64)
- Before this week, has never entered the final round of a PGA TOUR event higher than T6
- Making his third start in the Sanderson Farms Championship; T28/2019, MC/2018
- Seeks to become the seventh consecutive first-time winner at the Sanderson Farms Championship, joining Nick Taylor/2014, Peter Malnati/2015, Cody Gribble/2016, Ryan Armour/2017, Cameron Champ/2018 and Sebastian Munoz/2019
- In only other start this season, finished T36 at the Safeway Open
- Best finish in 51 PGA TOUR starts is T8/2020 The Honda Classic
- In 18 starts on the Korn Ferry Tour, claimed one victory (2018 Nashville Golf Open)

Sergio Garcia (T1/-14)

- Takes 54-hole lead/co-lead for 15th time, converting for the win on four occasions; most recently 2017 Masters Tournament
- In first Sanderson Farms Championship start, posted a bogey-free 66 in round three; has just three bogeys through 54 holes
- Comes off missed cuts in two previous starts this season (Safeway Open, U.S. Open)

- Seeks 11th career PGA TOUR victory and first since the 2017 Masters Tournament
- Winner of THE PLAYERS Championship in 2008
- Highlight of 10 made cuts in 12 starts last season was a T5 at the RBC Heritage, his 105th and most recent top-10 finish

J. T. Poston (T1/-14)

- Takes his first 54-hole lead/co-lead on the PGA TOUR after making a 12'11" putt for par on No. 18 in round three
- Sanderson Farms Championship history: T29/2016, T53/2017, T54/2018, T11/2019, TBD/2020
- Lone bogeys through 54 holes; No. 1/R2, No. 10/R3, No. 16/R3
- In only other start this season, missed the cut at the U.S. Open
- Lone PGA TOUR win came at the 2019 Wyndham Championship

Miscellaneous Notes

- Making his second Sanderson Farms Championship start (T45/2019), **Brandt Snedeker** (T4/-13) posted a 5-under 67 in his bid for a 10th PGA TOUR title and first since the 2018 Wyndham Championship
- With his 4-under 68, Norway's **Kristoffer Ventura** (T4/-13) has posted par-or-better scores in all 11 rounds he has played this season; finished T7 at Safeway Open and T52 at Corales Puntacana Resort & Club Championship
- With a 3-under 69, **Denny McCarthy** (T6/-12) has par-or-better scores in 12 of 13 rounds at the Country Club of Jackson
- 36-hole leader **Keegan Bradley** (T6/-12) eagled the par-5 11th hole for the second time this week (round one) en route to a 1-over 73; followed a 3-over 39 on the outgoing nine with a 2-under 34 coming in
- Making his fifth start in the Sanderson Farms Championship, **Charley Hoffman** (T9/-11) posted an even-par 72 to extend his streak of par-or-better rounds this season to a perfect 11-for 11
- A week after a career-best, solo-second at the Corales Puntacana Resort & Club Championship, **Tyler McCumber** (T9/-11) drove the green at the par-4 15th and sank the putt for eagle from 60'10" en route to a 6-under 66
