

### **Past Champions Notes**

- 7** Since the start of the 2013-14 season, all seven of the winners at the Sentry Tournament of Champions have been inside the top-five of the leaderboard entering the final round.
- 34.6%** Since 2014, the winners of the Sentry TOC have gained 34.6% of their total strokes gained for the week in their approach play. In this time frame, winners gain +1.10 strokes per round on approach shots at the Plantation Course at Kapalua.
- 14** 14 of the last 16 winners of the Sentry Tournament of Champions have ranked seventh or better in Strokes Gained: Approach-the-Green en route to victory.
- 4** Each of the last four Sentry TOC winners have ranked inside the top-10 in Greens in Regulation percentage.
- 37' 4"** Justin Thomas averaged 37' 4" in Proximity to the Hole en route to victory in 2020, ranking second in the field for the week. Thomas is the only winner of the Sentry TOC to rank inside the top two for Proximity to the Hole in the ShotLink era (four-round event).
- 9** Nine of the last 10 and each of the last five consecutive winners at this event have ranked third or better in Par 4 Birdie or Better percentage en route to victory at the Plantation Course at Kapalua.
- 13** 13 of the last 14 winners of the Sentry TOC have played the par 3s at the Plantation Course at Kapalua even par or better en route to victory.

- 13** The winner of the Sentry Tournament of Champions has qualified for the TOUR Championship in 13 of 14 seasons in the FedExCup era.
- 5** The last five winners of the Sentry TOC have finished inside the top-10 of the FedExCup at the conclusion of the TOUR Championship.
- 9** Nine of the Sentry TOC winners have been inside the FedExCup Top 10 after the conclusion of the regular season.
- 4** The Sentry TOC is one of four regular season events with the most winners qualifying for the TOUR Championship in the FedExCup era (13).
- 2** Sentry TOC & WGC-Mexico Championship are the only regular season events with an active streak of 12 consecutive seasons where the winner has qualified for the TOUR Championship.
- 8** Last season, eight players led for at least one week in the FedExCup standings, marking the sixth season where there were eight or more players who led in the standings in the FedExCup era.
- 15** Justin Thomas led for 15 of 33 weeks (45%), marking the most weeks ranked #1 in the FedExCup Standings of any player during the 2019-20 PGA TOUR season.
- 32.4** Entering the 2021 Sentry Tournament of Champions, the average age of the top-125 in the FedExCup is 32.4 with 45.6% of the top 125 players in their 30s (57).

<b>80.93%</b>	Had the easiest fairways to hit last season at 80.93%

<b>8</b>	There were eight putts made over 40 feet at this event in 2020, tied for the third most for a week at the Plantation Course at Kapalua in the ShotLink era (2012/11, 2019/10 & 2004/8)
<b>610</b>	Since 2003, there have been <b>610</b> drives of 400 yards or longer recorded on the PGA TOUR.
<b>33</b>	In 2020 there were <b>33</b> total 400+ yard drives recorded, marking the seventh season with more than 30 drives hit over this distance in the ShotLink Era (since 2003).

### Justin Thomas

13-time PGA TOUR winner and two-time winner of the Sentry Tournament of Champions, Justin Thomas is set to make his sixth appearance at this event.

#### Fast Facts on Justin Thomas:

- 13** Most PGA TOUR wins of players currently under 30 years of age (13)
- 68.40** Has the lowest opening round scoring average the Sentry TOC since 1999 (min 3 rds)
- 2** One of two players (Ernie Els, 2003) to complete the Hawaii slam, winning both the Sentry TOC & Sony Open in Hawaii in the same season (2017)
- +22.01** Justin Thomas has gained +22.01 total strokes on his approach play at the Plantation Course at Kapalua since 2016. In this time frame, Justin Thomas is over 11 strokes better than any other player in Strokes Gained: Approach-the-Green at this event.
- 128** Justin Thomas is 128-under par in Hawaii since 2015, 34 strokes better than the next best player (Jimmy Walker, -94). Since 2015, Thomas also has the most rounds in the 60s (26), most total birdies (200) and the most total eagles (12) of any player in Hawaii during this timeframe.
