Things to Know

- Harris English and Ryan Palmer are co-leaders at 21-under going into the final round of the Sentry Tournament of Champions
- Two-time tournament winner and defending champion Justin Thomas (T5) posts third-round 68 in search of his third win at the Sentry Tournament of Champions (2017, 2020) which would tie Stuart Appleby for most wins since the tournament moved to The Plantation Course at Kapalua
- The cumulative 54-hole scoring average (68.968) is the lowest at The Plantation Course since 1999
- Four past champions of the event are inside the top-10 (Thomas, Xander Schauffele, Dustin Johnson, Sergio Garcia)
- Celebrating his 41st birthday, Garcia made eight birdies en route to a 5-under 71

Harris English (-21/T1)

- English posts a bogey-free 7-under 66 marking his second third-round lead/co-lead on the PGA TOUR (2014 Farmers Insurance Open/T2)
- Has only recorded one bogey in his first 54 holes this week including not making a bogey in his last 47 holes
- R3 stats: 11/15 fairways, 16/18 greens, 27 putts
- Seeking third TOUR win in 250th start (2013 FedEx St. Jude Classic, 2013 Mayakoba Golf Classic)
- Qualified for the field with 12th place finish in the 2020 TOUR Championship

Ryan Palmer (-21/T1)

- Four-time PGA TOUR winner Ryan Palmer cards a bogey-free 9-under 64, highlighted by five consecutive birdies on the back nine (Nos. 12-16)
- Ranked No. 1 in Strokes Gained: Tee to Green (4.061) and Strokes Gained: Approach the Green (2.901) in the third round
- Seeks first win since capturing the 2019 Zurich Classic of New Orleans with playing partner Jon Rahm
- Has had success in Hawaii, capturing a victory at the 2010 Sony Open in Hawaii, winning by one stroke against Robert Allenby at Waialae Country Club
- R3 stats: 13/15 fairways, 17/18 greens, 28 putts
- Qualified for the field with a T24 finish in the 2020 TOUR Championship
- Holds the 54-hole lead/co-lead for the fifth time in individual stroke-play events, going on to win the 2010 Sony Open in Hawaii

Miscellaneous Notes

- **Justin Thomas** (T5) records an eagle on the par-5 5th hole, his 13th eagle in Hawaii since 2015, most of any player. Four of the 13 eagles recorded at The Plantation Course
- **Billy Horschel** (T7) posted his second consecutive 7-under 66, has now played his last 41 holes without a bogey. Hit every green in regulation marking the fourth time in his career to hit every GIR in a round

- Reigning FedExCup champion and two-time Sentry Tournament of Champions winner **Dustin Johnson** (T10) posted a third-round 4-under 69
- Adam Scott (T21) hit all 18 Greens in Regulation in the third-round, marking the 4th time in his career hitting all 18 greens. He has only missed two greens in regulation for the week (52 of 54). His 52 greens hit marks his most through opening 54 holes in a PGA TOUR event
