Things to Know

- Justin Thomas shares opening-round lead with Harris English in bid to become first player since Geoff Ogilvy in 2010 to successfully defend title at the event; marks his ninth opening-round lead/co-lead on TOUR
- English holds his fourth first-round lead/co-lead in his 250th career start on the PGA TOUR
- 2002 Sentry Tournament of Champions winner Sergio Garcia cards 6-under 67 in first start at Kapalua since 2006
- After a 3-over start, Ryan Palmer's scorecard includes two eagles and four straight birdies en route to a 6-under 67
- FedExCup leader and World No. 1 Dustin Johnson records an opening-round 2-under 71

Justin Thomas (65/T1)

- Two-time tournament winner and defending champion posts opening round 65 to share lead with Harris English
- Holds first-round lead/co-lead for the ninth time (four wins)
- Seeks third win at the event (2017, 2020), which would tie Stuart Appleby for most wins since the tournament moved to The Plantation Course at Kapalua
- Looking to become first player to successfully defend title at the event since Geoff Ogilvy in 2010

- Opened with 67 in both of his wins at the Sentry Tournament of Champions (2017, 2020)
- R1 stats: 11/15 fairways, 16/18 greens, 28 putts
- Is 77-under in six starts at the tournament; is 46-under in his last 10 rounds at The Plantation Course
- Marks his 27th round in the 60s in Hawaii TOUR events since 2015 (most of any player)
- One career successful title defense on TOUR (2016 CIMB Classic)
- Has finished T12 or better in each of his last six starts, dating back to a T2 at the 2020 TOUR Championship

Harris English (65/T1)

- Marks his lowest opening-round score in relation to par on TOUR
- Holds the first-round lead/co-lead for the fourth time: 2013 FedEx St. Jude Classic (won), 2020 Honda Classic (T17), 2020
 The NORTHERN TRUST (2), 2021 Sentry Tournament of Champions (TBD)
- R1 stats: 15/15 fairways, 15/18 greens, 26 putts
- Seeking third TOUR win in 250th start (2013 FedEx St. Jude Classic, 2014 Mayakoba Golf Classic)
- Qualified for the field with 12th place finish in the 2020 TOUR Championship

Miscellaneous Notes

- 2002 Sentry Tournament of Champions winner **Sergio Garcia** (T3) cards 6-under 67 in first start at the event since 2006; began round 2-over through three holes
- Ryan Palmer (T3) started his day 3-over through four holes before closing with a 6-under 67; round highlighted by two eagles (Nos. 5 & 9) and four straight birdies (Nos. 13-16); had never broken 70 in the first round in four prior starts at the Sentry Tournament of Champions
- **Robert Streb** (T3) opened 67 in both starts at the Sentry Tournament of Champions (2015, 2021); qualified by winning his last start (2020 The RSM Classic)
- In his tournament debut, Sungjae Im (T3) had five straight birdies on Nos. 10-14 en route to a 6-under 67
- Patrick Reed's bogey-free 6-under 67 included a birdie-eagle finish; 2015 tournament winner also has runner-up finishes at The Plantation Course in 2016 and 2020
- Reigning FedExCup champion and World No. 1 Dustin Johnson (T30) posted a 2-under 71
