- 558' 11"** Defending champion Kevin Na set a ShotLink and personal record for most feet of putts made in a PGA TOUR event in the ShotLink era. Kevin made 558' 11" of putts en route to victory at TPC Summerlin in 2019.
- +14.176** Kevin Na was over 14 strokes better than the field on the greens, gaining +14.176 total strokes in Strokes Gained: Putting en route to victory, marking the best SG: Putting performance of any player in the ShotLink era.
- 1st** Since 2017, Patrick Cantlay leads the TOUR at the Shriners Hospitals for Children Open in Rounds Par or Better (12), Birdies or Better (73), Score to Par (-52), times inside top-10 of the leaderboard (10) and Total Strokes Gained: Tee-to-Green (+31.93).
- 3** Patrick Cantlay is one of three players with at least three top-two finishes at the Shriners Hospitals for Children Open.

- 8** Last season, Bryson DeChambeau ranked inside the top-five for Strokes Gained: Off-the-Tee in eight events, marking his most in a season on TOUR over the last four seasons.

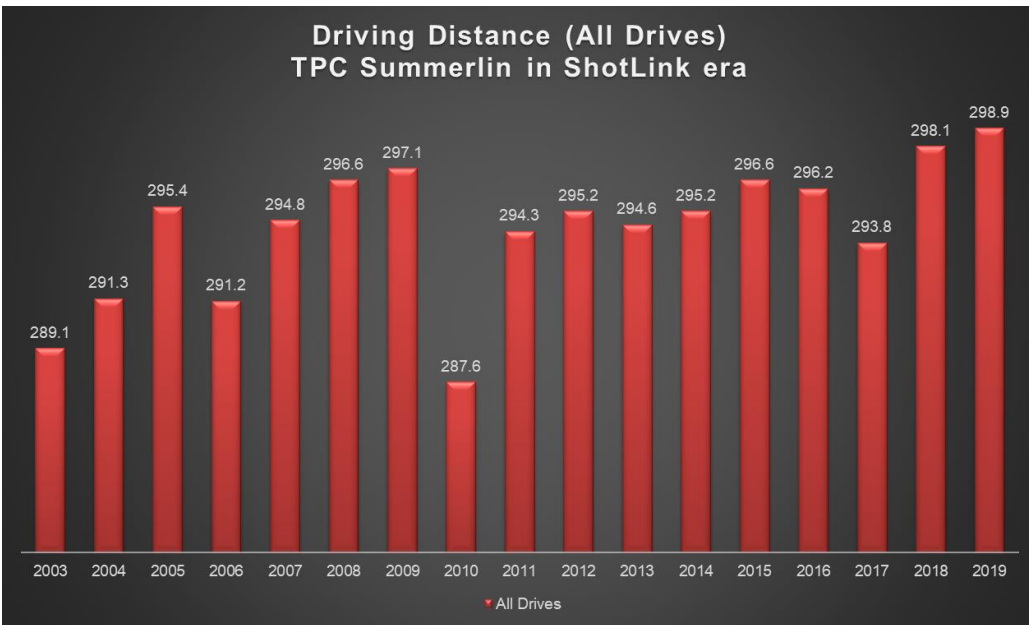
