

FedExCup Storylines

- **4** Since 2013-14 PGA TOUR season, four of the last seven winners at The American Express have qualified for the TOUR Championship.
- **1,515** Since 2009, Bill Haas has earned the most FedExCup points at this event (1,515).
- **+88** With his win last week at the Sony Open in Hawaii, Kevin Na moved 88 positions from 98th to 10th in the FedExCup, marking his 49th week ranked inside the top 10 of the FedExCup.
- Since the start of the FedExCup era (2007), six of the 14 American Express champions made this event the site of their first win on the PGA TOUR (last: Adam Long, 2019).
- 13 of the current top 30 of the FedExCup are in the field this week, Patrick Cantlay (7th) is the highest ranked player in the FedExCup in the field this week.

Andrew Landry

Defending The American Express champion Andrew Landry made 31 total birdies en route to his victory at this event in 2020.

Fast Facts on Andrew Landry:

- Needed just 99 putts at this event last season, marking the second consecutive winner at this event needing less than 100 total putts and the fewest total putts in an event of Landry's PGA TOUR career.
- -70 Andrew Landry is 70-under par at The American Express, marking his best score to par at an event on TOUR and the third best of any player at this event over the last five seasons
- **+2.78** Andrew Landry outperformed the field by +2.78 total strokes on approach shots in the Final Round, hitting 15 of 18 greens in regulation and 13 approach shots inside 25 feet. Landry's total strokes gained on his iron play marked his second-best Final Round total Strokes Gained: Approach-the-Green performance of his PGA TOUR career.
