Today – Mostly sunny with clouds expected to increase by late this morning. Isolated showers or drizzle will become possible after 12pm, with widely scattered showers expected to be in the Coachella Valley towards the end of round 3. Total rainfall of a few hundredths of an inch will be possible through 5pm. Scattered showers are expected overnight/early Sunday, with an additional few hundredth of an inch of rainfall possible. Temperatures will top out in the low 60s, while the overnight low will be in the mid-40s.

Tomorrow – Outside an isolated light shower or drizzle prior to 8am, expect dry conditions on Sunday with clouds decreasing by mid-morning. The temperature will start out in the mid-40s and patchy frost is no longer anticipated. Temperatures are forecast to warm into the mid-60s under partly cloudy to mostly sunny skies. Westerly winds may increase for the last couple hours of play, with gusts to 15 mph between 2-4pm. Showers will become likely overnight into Monday as a stronger system moves into the region.
