

- 3** Cameron Champ is seeking first cut made at the Genesis Invitational. The Genesis Invitational is one of three PGA TOUR events where Cameron Champ has yet to make the cut (*the Memorial Tournament & Arnold Palmer Invitational*).
- 6** Rory Mcllroy has finished inside the top 25 in all six starts this season. Mcllroy is one of five players who have finished 25th or better in every start this season (*min 2 starts*).
- 7** Bryson DeChambeau is one of four players who have been inside the top 20 of the leaderboard after seven of the last eight rounds at The Genesis Invitational (since 2019).
- 5.32** Justin Thomas leads the TOUR in Birdie Average (5.32) this season and has ranked inside the top four in Birdie Average in each of the last four seasons. Justin Thomas is the only player to rank inside the top four in more than one season since the start of the 2016-17 season.

Schauffele has not finished outside the top 25 in an event on TOUR since the 2020 RBC Heritage (T64). The last player to record 16 or more consecutive top 25s on TOUR was Rory Mcllroy (*2013 WGC-HSBC Champions – 2014 TOUR Championship/17 events*).
- 4** Collin Morikawa is one of four players who rank inside the top 20 in both Driving Accuracy and Greens in Regulation this season.
- 22** Jon Rahm has the third longest active streak of rounds par or better on TOUR (22). Rahm's longest streak of rounds par or better on TOUR is 25 (*2016 RBC Canadian Open, Rd 1 – 2016 Mayakoba Golf Classic, Rd 3*).
- 1st** Patrick Cantlay moved to No. 1 in the FedExCup with his T3 finish at the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am, marking the first time in his career to lead in the FedExCup standings. Cantlay is the 66th different player to rank No.1 in the FedExCup in at least one week since the start of the FedExCup.
- 12** Dustin Johnson has the most rounds of 66 or better of any player at this event since 2008 (12), seven more than the next player (Bubba Watson & Phil Mickelson/5).
- 28' 11"** Bubba Watson has the second-best proximity to the hole average on approaches from 175 to 200 yards at Riviera CC since 2007 (min 15 Rds). Watson averages 28' 11" in proximity on these approach shots in this time frame. Since 2014, the winner of this event has ranked inside the top 15 in Approaches from 175-200 yards in five seasons.
- 5** Adam Scott made five putts from outside 10 feet in the Final Round en route to victory in 2020, tied for his most putts made over this distance in the Final Round on TOUR in the ShotLink era (3rd time with five putts made)
