







Today – A weakening cold front will be moving through the area with an isolated light shower or two possible through 9AM. Otherwise, mostly cloudy skies will give way to partly cloudy skies this afternoon. It will be a little cooler today with highs in the low 80s and lower humidity as well.

Extended Forecast – Cooler temperatures and less humid conditions continue Saturday with highs in the 70s. A weak area of low pressure will develop off the Florida coast that will increase the moisture enough to produce a few showers along the coast both Saturday and Sunday. However, the bulk of the moisture should remain off-shore as the low moves slowly to the northeast. High pressure builds back over the region Monday with mostly sunny skies and highs in the upper 70s.
