








Today – Southerly winds will pump warmer and more humid conditions across the area today with highs reaching the mid to upper 80s. Southerly winds of 15-20 gusting to 25-30 mph at times can be expected this afternoon as well. Can't rule out an isolated shower developing towards evening, but most area will remain dry today.

Extended Forecast – An approaching cold front will bring the chance for a few showers and isolated thunderstorms to the area Friday morning before shifting to the south by mid-day. Mostly cloudy skies will become partly cloudy during the afternoon with highs in the low 80s. Cooler temperatures and less humid conditions will return on Saturday with highs in the upper 70s. An area of low pressure will develop off the Florida coast on Sunday, producing the chance for scattered showers along the coast. The bulk of the rain should remain well off-shore over the Atlantic as the low slowly moves to the east.
