**Today** – A band of rain and a few embedded thunderstorms is likely to focus 10-20 miles northwest of the course through the mid-morning hours, with a few showers and possibly a thunderstorm developing southeast of this area/closer to the course. Additional showers and thunderstorms will begin popping up to the west and northwest around midday, building to a scattered/broken line of thunderstorms that are expected to move through during the afternoon hours. The highest potential for thunderstorms is anticipated between 3-6pm. The coverage of precipitation should quickly diminish after 7pm as the system departs to the east and instability weakens. **Additional forecast rainfall through 8pm Thursday: 0.30" – 0.60", locally higher in thunderstorms.**
