Things to Know

- Justin Thomas and Jon Rahm share the 18-hole lead after matching 8-under 63s, three strokes better than any other player
- Thomas and Rahm both entered the week in the top 10 in the FedExCup standings and top five in the Official World Golf Ranking
- Bryson DeChambeau (71) becomes the fourth player on record (since 1983) to make two or fewer pars and record a score of even-par or better
- Harold Varner III (FedExCup No. 72 entering the week) finished T3 at THE NORTHERN TRUST at Liberty National in 2019, moving inside the top 70 to qualify for the BMW Championship
- Players currently projected to move inside the top 70 (6): Harold Varner III, Adam Scott, Andrew Putnam, Erik van Rooyen, Keith Mitchell, Harry Higgs
- Players currently projected to fall out of the top 70 (6): Shane Lowry, Tyrrell Hatton, Talor Gooch, Martin Laird,

Justin Thomas (T1/-8)

- 10th career 18-hole lead/co-lead on TOUR; 4-for-9 to date converting to victory (2016 CIMB Classic, 2017 Sony Open in Hawaii, 2017 THE CJ CUP @ NINE BRIDGES, 2019 BMW Championship)
- Third 18-hole lead/co-lead of the season, tied with Sebastian Munoz for most on the PGA TOUR
- Eighth lead/co-lead after any round in a FedExCup Playoffs event, second-most in FedExCup Playoffs history (Dustin Johnson, 12)
- Fourth career first-round score of 63 or better on TOUR and first since 2017 THE CJ CUP @ NINE BRIDGES (Won)
- Entered the week with a stroke average of 68.79 in FedExCup Playoffs events, fourth-lowest in FedExCup Playoffs history (min. 50 rounds)
- 14-time PGA TOUR winner, the most among players currently younger than 30
- Won THE PLAYERS Championship earlier in the season (only player to win THE PLAYERS and the FedExCup in the same season: Rory McIlroy, 2019)
- 2017 FedExCup champion; two career wins in the FedExCup Playoffs (2017 Dell Technologies Championship, 2019 BMW Championship)
- Leads the field in Strokes Gained: Approach the Green (4.595)

Jon Rahm (T1/-8)

- Seventh career 18-hole lead/co-lead on TOUR; 1-for-6 to date converting to victory (2018 The American Express)
- Fourth career first-round score of 63 or better on TOUR and first since the 2019 World Golf Championships-FedEx St.
 Jude Invitational
- Entered the week with a stroke average of 68.43 in FedExCup Playoffs events, lowest in FedExCup Playoffs history (min. 50 rounds)
- Last three starts on the PGA TOUR: WD/the Memorial Tournament presented by Workday (led by six strokes after 54 holes and was forced to withdraw), Won/U.S. Open, T3/The Open Championship
- Leads the field in Strokes Gained: Tee to Green (6.759)
- Six-time PGA TOUR winner, including the 2021 U.S. Open
- One career win in the FedExCup Playoffs (2020 BMW Championship)
- Leads the PGA TOUR in top-10 finishes this season with 12

Miscellaneous Notes

- Harold Varner III stands solo-third after a 5-under 66; Varner, who entered the week No. 72 in the FedExCup standings, was one of four players to enter 2019 THE NORTHERN TRUST outside the top 70 in the FedExCup standings and go on to qualify for the BMW Championship (T3; moved from No. 102 to 29th)
- Bryson DeChambeau (T52) made two pars en route to an even-par 71; DeChambeau, who co-leads the field in birdies with nine, became the fourth player on record (since 1983) to make two or fewer pars and record a score of even-par or better (most recent: Jarrod Lyle, 2011 John Deere Classic)
- Adam Scott records a 4-under 67 in his first round since losing in a playoff at the Wyndham Championship; last player to lose in a playoff and win the following week: Dustin Johnson (lost in a playoff at 2020 BMW

Championship, won 2020 TOUR Championship)

• Defending champion and 2020 FedExCup champion Dustin Johnson cards a 1-under 70 and stands T34
