- Jon Rahm leads THE NORTHERN TRUST after recording the second-lowest 36-hole total of his PGA TOUR career (130)
- Tony Finau ties his career-best 36-hole total at 131, sits in solo-second
- Xander Schauffele and Jordan Spieth post matching rounds of 9-under 62, tying the course record at Liberty National G.C.
- Defending champion and 2020 FedExCup Champion Dustin Johnson, FedExCup leader Collin Morikawa miss the cut
- Players currently projected to move inside the top 70 (6): Keith Mitchell, Harold Varner III, Alex Noren, Tom Hoge, Erik van Rooyen, Seamus Power

### Jon Rahm (1st/-12)

- Fifth career 36-hole lead/co-lead on TOUR; 0-for-4 to date converting to victory, with a T3 at the 2016 Quicken Loans National as his best finish (forced to WD from the 2021 Memorial Tournament presented by Nationwide after 54 holes)
- Records 12 birdies against zero bogeys through 36 holes; becomes the 13<sup>th</sup> player to play the first 36 holes of a FedExCup Playoffs event without a bogey
- Records the second-lowest 36-hole total of his TOUR career at 130 (129/2018 The American Express)
- Entered the week with a stroke average of 68.43 in FedExCup Playoffs events, lowest in FedExCup Playoffs history (min. 50 rounds)
- Last three starts on the PGA TOUR: WD/the Memorial Tournament presented by Workday (led by six strokes after 54 holes and was forced to withdraw), Won/U.S. Open, T3/The Open Championship
- Leads the field in Strokes Gained: Tee to Green (8.558)
- Six-time PGA TOUR winner has one career win in the FedExCup Playoffs (2020 BMW Championship)
- Leads the PGA TOUR in top-10 finishes this season with 12

# Tony Finau (2<sup>nd</sup>/-11)

- Ties his career-best 36-hole total on TOUR at 131; recorded four times prior, the last coming at the 2020 3M Open (T3)
- Owns one career win on the PGA TOUR (2016 Puerto Rico Open) while amassing eight runner-up finishes, including two
  during the 2020-21 season (Farmers Insurance Open, The Genesis Invitational); making his 143<sup>rd</sup> start since the win in
  Puerto Rico
- Entered the week with seven top-10 finishes this season, but none in his last seven starts dating back to a T8 at the PGA Championship in May
- Has one top-10 finish in six career starts at THE NORTHERN TRUST, finishing runner-up to Bryson DeChambeau at the 2018 event (Ridgewood C.C.)
- Has advanced to the TOUR Championship each of the last five seasons, recording a career-best sixth-place finish in the 2018 FedExCup

#### **Miscellaneous Notes**

- Olympic gold medalist **Xander Schauffele** (T3) records two eagles in his first eight holes en route to a course-record-tying 9-under 62 at Liberty National G.C. (Kevin Chappell/2013, Troy Merritt/2019); matches his career-best on TOUR (2019 Sentry Tournament of Champions/R4)
- Jordan Spieth (T10) matches course-record 62 playing in the grouping behind Schauffele; records back-to-back eagles on the par-4 fifth and par-5 sixth, marking his first time doing so in 743 career rounds on TOUR, and the second time with multiple eagles in a round (2015 John Deere Classic/R3)
- First-round co-leader **Justin Thomas** (T3) recorded four bogeys in his first eight holes before closing in 5-under 31 for a second-round 69; marks the fourth time he has shot par or better in his TOUR career after playing his first nine holes in 3-over or worse; 2017 FedExCup champion owns two career wins in the FedExCup Playoffs (2017 Dell Technologies Championship, 2019 BMW Championship)
- Harold Varner III (T6/-9), currently No. 72 in the FedExCup standings, was one of four players to enter the 2019 THE

NORTHERN TRUST outside the top 70 in the FedExCup standings and go on to qualify for the BMW Championship (T3; moved from No. 102 to 29<sup>th</sup>); marked the second time in his career in which he moved into the cutoff (2017) at this event, one of just five players in FedExCup Playoffs history to do so multiple times

- **Keith Mitchell** (T3) birdied Nos. 12-17 on his outward nine en route to a second-round 64; Mitchell is the only player on TOUR with multiple birdie streaks of six or more holes this season (3M Open/R3/10-16)
- **C.T. Pan** (MC) recorded a hole-in-one on No. 4 (193 yards, 5-iron), marking the first hole-in-one at THE NORTHERN TRUST since 2018 (J.T. Poston)
- Defending champion and 2020 FedExCup champion **Dustin Johnson** misses the cut with rounds of 70-72—142; marks his fourth missed cut of the season, which is his most since 2013 (4)
- FedExCup leader **Collin Morikawa** misses the cut with rounds of 74-70—144 (+2)
