### Things to Know

- Tony Finau defeats Cameron Smith in a playoff, earning his second PGA TOUR title
- The win comes in Finau's 143<sup>rd</sup> start since his first victory on TOUR (2016 Puerto Rico Open)
- World No. 1 Jon Rahm, who held at least a share of the lead after each of the first three rounds, plays the final four holes in 2-over and finishes solo-third
- Keith Mitchell birdies each of the final three holes to move into the top 70 in the FedExCup standings and qualify for the BMW Championship
- Players moving into the top 70 in the FedExCup standings and qualifying for the BMW Championship (6): Alex Noren (T4), Erik van Rooyen (7<sup>th</sup>), Tom Hoge (T4), Harold Varner III (T11), Mitchell (T8), Harry Higgs (T16)

- Win comes 1,975 days and 143 starts since first victory at the 2016 Puerto Rico Open

- In the 142 starts between victories, Finau recorded eight runner-up finishes and 39 top-10s
- Moves to No. 1 in the FedExCup standings for the first time in his career
- Improves to 2-3 in playoffs on TOUR (losses: 2018 World Golf Championships-HSBC Champions, 2020 Waste Management Phoenix Open, 2021 The Genesis Invitational)

- Third consecutive week on the PGA TOUR schedule with a playoff (first time with three straight since 2019 The RSM Classic, 2020 Sentry Tournament of Champions, 2020 Sony Open in Hawaii)
- 13<sup>th</sup> playoff of the PGA TOUR season
- Updated playoff records: Finau, 2-3; Smith, 3-1

#### **Tropical Storm Henri notes**

- The final round moved to Monday due to Tropical Storm Henri
- Last unscheduled Monday finish on the PGA TOUR: 2019 ZOZO CHAMPIONSHIP
- Last time fans were not allowed to attend a tournament round for a reason other than COVID-19 restrictions: Saturday,

## Additional player notes

- 14 consecutive PGA TOUR events have been won by players that trailed after each of the first three rounds; the last player to lead after any round and go on to win was Phil Mickelson at the 2021 PGA Championship (T1/R2, 1<sup>st</sup>/R3)
- Cameron Smith, who carded a career-low and course-record-setting 60 in the third round, falls in a playoff to Tony Finau, earns his second runner-up of the season and first since the 2020 Masters Tournament; Smith enters the BMW Championship at a career-high No. 3 in the FedExCup standings
- World No. 1 **Jon Rahm** (3<sup>rd</sup>) plays the final four holes in 2-over to miss the playoff by two strokes; Rahm held at least a share of the lead after each of the first three rounds
- **Keith Mitchell**, who entered the week No. 101 in the FedExCup standings, makes birdie on each of the final three holes to finish T8, moving to No. 63 in the FedExCup standings and qualifying for the BMW Championship (only player to birdie 16-17-18 in the final round); this is Mitchell's third appearance at the penultimate FedExCup Playoffs event in four seasons on TOUR
- Harold Varner III (72 to 56 in the FedExCup standings) moves inside the cut line for the following FedExCup Playoffs event for the third time at THE NORTHERN TRUST (2017, 2019, 2021); the only other player to do so three or more times is Camilo Villegas (2011, 2013, 2015)
