## **Outlook for the rest of the Championship**

- Friday: A dry day with extensive early cloud breaking from mid-late morning onwards leaving a sunny afternoon and evening. Winds: N or NE 10-13 mph, gusts 17-22 mph. Max temps 20 °C.
- Saturday: Fine and dry again. Probably sunny for much of the day, but a small risk of low cloud encroaching from the North Sea. Winds: N or NE 10-14 mph, gusts 18-24 mph. Max temps 20 °C.
- Sunday: Another dry day with prolonged sunshine likely for much, if not all of the day. Warm. Winds: N or NE 6-10 mph, gusts 10-15 mph (AM). NE or E 6-10 mph, gusts 10-15 mph (PM). Max temps 23 °C.
