

- 66** Since 2007, there has been 66 different players who have ranked #1 in the FedExCup standings in at least one week of FedExCup era.

Dustin Johnson is set to make his 12th start at THE PLAYERS and 281st of his PGA TOUR career. The 24-time PGA TOUR winner and 2020 FedExCup champion is one of eight players in the field this week who have won the FedExCup.

Bryson DeChambeau

Eight-time PGA TOUR winner Bryson DeChambeau is set to make his third start at THE PLAYERS. On the strength of two wins and five top-25 finishes, Bryson currently leads the FedExCup for the 12th week of his PGA TOUR career (T13 most all-time).
