Things to Know

- Each of the last four 36-hole leaders/co-leaders of The RSM Classic has converted for the win
- 2014 The RSM Classic winner Robert Streb in position to become the event's first two-time winner after tying his career-low score, his second time of shooting 63 in the event
- Peter Malnati is now 60-under par in his first 20 rounds on TOUR this season, a stark contrast to +5 in his last 20 stroke-play rounds of the 2019-20 season
- Bronson Burgoon makes six birdies in a 7-hole stretch to bid for his first TOUR title in his 97th start
- Sea Island resident Harris English closes in on a third top-10 finish in his fifth start of the season

- Winner of the 2014 The RSM Classic birdied five of his first eight holes en route to a career-low-tying 9-under 63
- Lone bogey through 36 holes came at his 11th hole on the Seaside Course in round one
- Hit 17 of 18 greens in regulation
- Takes 36-hole lead/co-lead on TOUR for a third time (2015 Wells Fargo Championship/T4, 2016 PGA Championship/T7)

- With a win this week, would become the first player to have his first two TOUR victories come at the same event since Daniel Berger (2016-17 FedEx St. Jude Classic)
- Seeks to become the first two-time winner of The RSM Classic
- Is making his seventh start in The RSM Classic; since his 2014 victory, has yet to finish higher than T25 (2015)
- Was T10 through 36 holes in the 2014 event, before closing with a 7-under 63 and winning in sudden death over Brendon de Jonge and Will MacKenzie
- Best finish in four starts this season is T21/Corales Puntacana Resort & Club Championship
- Comes off a season defined by just seven made cuts in 19 starts

Miscellaneous Notes

- **Camilo Villegas** (-12/2nd) followed a 6-under 64 in round one with a 6-under 66 on the Plantation Course, highlighted by an eagle-3 at his last hole of the day, No. 18; heads into the weekend in good position for a fifth PGA TOUR title and first since the 2014 Wyndham Championship; 130 marks his career-low 36-hole score on TOUR
- Sea Island's **Patton Kizzire** (-11/T3) birdied his last three holes on the Plantation Course (Nos. 7-9) to post a 6-under 66; best finish in six previous starts at The RSM Classic is T15 in 2018
- **Bronson Burgoon** (-11/T3) birdied six holes in a 7-hole stretch (Nos. 7-13) en route to a bogey-free 9-under 63, one stroke shy of his career-low
- Sea Island resident **Harris English** (-10/T5) birdied seven of his last 11 holes (Plantation) en route to a 6-under 66; seeks his third top-10 finish of the season in his fifth start (4th/U.S. Open, 10th/THE CJ CUP @ SHADOW CREEK)
- Including today's 2-under 70, **Peter Malnati** (-7/T11) is now a collective 60-under par through his first 20 rounds this season with only two over-par scores; by comparison, in his last 20 stroke-play rounds of the 2019-20 season, he was a collective 5-over par with nine over-par scores
- In his fifth The RSM Classic start, **Joel Dahmen** (-7/T11) followed a 2-over 74 with a career-low 9-under 61 (Seaside)
- **Matt Wallace** (-7/T11), who led after 18 holes with a 6-under 64, posted a 1-under 71 in round two and is seven strokes back
- Other area residents of note: **Zach Johnson** (-9/7th), **Keith Mitchell** (-7/T11), **Matt Kuchar** (-6/T22)
- Sponsor exemption **Davis Thompson**, the No. 1 player in the World Amateur Golf Ranking and son of Tournament Director Todd Thompson, missed the cut after rounds of 77-73—150 (+8)
