Things to Know

- 2014 The RSM Classic winner Robert Streb ties the record for largest 54-hole lead in tournament history
- Saint Simons Island resident Zach Johnson ties the day's low score of 5-under 65 with a 31'11" birdie on his last hole; in position for first The RSM Classic title in his 11th effort
- Bronson Burgoon makes five birdies on a 6-hole stretch in bid for first career PGA TOUR win in 97th start
- Emiliano Grillo plays his last four holes in 4-under par to shoot 5-under 65 and tie the low round of the day
- With one bogey through 54 holes, 2015 The RSM Classic winner Kevin Kisner improves position with a 4-under 66
- Making his 330th career PGA TOUR start, a win for Camilo Villegas Sunday would come in his 103rd start since his fourth and most recent TOUR victory

- A win Sunday would come in his 165th PGA TOUR start since his 2014 The RSM Classic victory
- With a win, would become the first player to capture his first two TOUR victories at the same event since Daniel Berger (2016-17 FedEx St. Jude Classic)
- With a win, would become the first two-time winner of The RSM Classic
- With a win, would become the fifth consecutive player to convert a 36-hole lead/co-lead into victory at The RSM Classic
- Three-stroke lead ties the record for largest 54-hole lead in tournament history
- Lone bogey through 54 holes came at the 11th hole in round hole (Plantation Course)

- Is making his seventh start in The RSM Classic; since his 2014 victory, has yet to finish higher than T25 (2015)
- Was T12 and five strokes off the lead through 54 holes in the 2014 event, before closing with a 7-under 63 and winning in sudden death over Brendon de Jonge and Will MacKenzie
- In 40 starts on the Korn Ferry Tour, won twice (most recently the 2018 Nationwide Children's Hospital Championship over Peter Malnati in sudden death)

Miscellaneous Notes

- Saint Simons Island resident **Zach Johnson** (-14/T2) tied the low round of the day with a 5-under 65, highlighted by a 31'11" birdie on the last hole; seeks a 13th career TOUR title and first since the 2015 The Open Championship; In 10 previous The RSM Classic starts, finished in the top 10 in 2017 (T8) and 2018 (T7)
- Following his bogey-free 9-under 63 in round two, **Bronson Burgoon** (-14/T2) birdied five holes in a 6-hole stretch on the inward nine to shoot 3-under 67 and stay well within reach of his first career TOUR title; in four previous starts at The RSM Classic, has three missed three cuts and a T70
- Making his first start in The RSM Classic, **Emiliano Grillo** (-13/4th) played Nos. 15-18 eagle-par-birdie-birdie to tie the day's low round of 5-under 65
- 2015 The RSM Classic winner **Kevin Kisner** (-12/T5) posted a bogey-free 4-under 66 as he looks to become the event's first two-time champion; en route to 2015 win, posted 6-under 64 in rounds three and four to win by six strokes; seeks fourth career TOUR title and first since the 2019 World Golf Championships-Dell Technologies Match Play
- **Camilo Villegas** (-12/T5) posted an even-par 70 as he looks for a fifth TOUR title and first since the 2014 Wyndham Championship
