A coastal trough will be developing today, and this will likely produce widely scattered showers along the coast that will move inland from time to time this afternoon into the evening hours.

Extended Forecast – High pressure to the north will dominate our weather through the end of the week allowing temperatures to moderate late in the week into the weekend with highs returning to the 70s. The long stretch of northeasterly wind off the Atlantic will combine with a coastal trough to produce isolated to widely scattered showers each day through the weekend. Showers can happen anytime, but most of the days will remain dry.
