Things To Know

- For the third season, the TOUR Championship is weighted by FedExCup Starting Strokes, with the format crowning a single champion; at the conclusion of the TOUR Championship, the player with the lowest score in relation to par combined with his FedExCup Starting Strokes will win the TOUR Championship and the FedExCup
- FedExCup leader Patrick Cantlay (-13) began at 10-under with a two-stroke advantage and maintained that advantage
- Jon Rahm opens with 5-under 65 for a second consecutive year
- Harris English scores the first hole-in-one at No. 15 at East Lake during the TOUR Championship
- Bryson DeChambeau birdies the final three holes to shoot 1-under 69

Patrick Cantlay (1st/-13)

- FedExCup leader began at 10-under with a two-stroke advantage and maintains that advantage with 3-under 67
- Before Thursday's 67, was 9-over in his previous three rounds at East Lake (73-75-71)
- Making fourth appearance at TOUR Championship (T21/2019, T21/2018, T20/2017)
- Seeks fourth title this season, his first season with more than one victory
- Won last week's BMW Championship following T11 at THE NORTHERN TRUST, the first FedExCup Playoffs event

Jon Rahm (2nd/-11)

• 2021 U.S. Open champion fires 5-under 65 to sit 11-under and two strokes back after starting four strokes behind

- Makes seven birdies, the most of any player in the field
- Opens with 65 for the second consecutive year; opening rounds at East Lake since 2017: 67-68-68-65-65
- Making fifth appearance at the TOUR Championship (4th/2020, T12/2019, T11/2018, T7/2017)
- Notched top-10 results at first two FedExCup Playoffs events (T3/THE NORTHERN TRUST, T9/BMW Championship)

Harris English (T3/-8)

- Seeks third title this season, his first season with more than one victory
- Holes a 5-iron for the first hole-in-one at the 224-yard 15th hole at the TOUR Championship en route to a 5-under 65; marks his second ace on TOUR (No. 17/R2/2018 Corales Puntacana Championship)
- With ace-birdie-birdie on holes 15-17, becomes the first player to play that stretch of holes in 4-under in a round at East Lake during the TOUR Championship
- Ranks No. 1 in Strokes gained: Tee To Green (4.659) and Strokes Gained: Approach The Green (4.271) after round one

Bryson DeChambeau (T3/-8)

- After being defeated on the sixth hole of a sudden-death playoff at last week's BMW Championship, birdies final three holes for 1-under 69 but falls five strokes back after starting three behind at 7-under
- Ranks No. 1 in Strokes Gained: Off the Tee (1.709) and No. 1 in Driving Distance (317); also ranks T1 in Driving Accuracy, hitting 11 of 14 fairways in the opening round
- Seeks his first top-10 in fourth appearance at the TOUR Championship (22/2020, T12/2019, 19/2018)

Additional Player Notes

- **Viktor Hovland** (T5/-7) ranks No. 1 in Proximity (22' 11") after hitting 15 of 18 greens; finished T20 in 2020 in his only previous start at the TOUR Championship (69-69-68-70)
- 2017 FedExCup champion **Justin Thomas** (T5/-7) shoots 4-under 31 on back nine en route to 3-under 67, marking the sixth time in six starts at this event with a par-or-better opening round
- **Kevin Na** (T8/-6) hit 11 of 14 fairways to rank T1 in Driving Accuracy while equaling his low score at the TOUR Championship in 28 rounds at East Lake (66/R2/2014)
- **Billy Horschel** (T10/-5), one of five players in the field who have a win at East Lake, hit 15 of 18 greens en route to a bogey-free 5-under 65 (the lone bogey-free round of the day), matching his low score in 17 rounds at this event (65/R2/2018)
- 2020 FedExCup champion Dustin Johnson (T10/-5) birdies his final two holes to sit eight strokes back after starting seven back
- Sergio Garcia (T23/-2) holes an 8-iron from 160 yards for eagle at the par-4 first hole to become the second player to make eagle on the opening hole of the TOUR Championship since 2007 (Jim Furyk/2008); marks the fourth time since 2003 that Garcia has made an eagle at the opening hole of a PGA TOUR event
