Weather: Light showers in the morning. Mostly cloudy with a high of 77. Wind SSE 6-14 mph.

36-hole cut: 79 players at 2-under 138 from a field of 156 professionals.

Things to Know

- At 9-under 131, Jason Day holds first 36-hole lead/co-lead in a non-major since 2017 AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am
- Bubba Watson opens with back-to-back rounds of 66 or better for the third time in his TOUR career
- Kramer Hickok seeks first career TOUR victory in his 68th start
- K.H. Lee made eagle on the par-5 13th hole and par-4 15th hole, marking the first time in his career with multiple eagles in one round
- Defending Travelers Championship winner Dustin Johnson sits T58 at 2-under

- Beginning on No. 10, Australia native notched eight birdies en route to bogey-free 8-under 62; marks lowest score in 24 rounds at the Travelers Championship (previously: 63/R2/2019)
- Sank 119'3" of putts, highlighted by a 36'5" birdie putt on No. 5; one of five putts made from outside 10 feet
- Last 36-hole lead/co-lead in a non-major on TOUR was 2017 AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am (T5)
- In six previous Travelers Championship starts, has three top-20 finishes and one missed cut with his best finish T8 in 2019
- Remains in search of his 13th career TOUR victory and first since 2018 Wells Fargo Championship; T7 at Vivint Houston Open and T7 at AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am earlier this season mark best finishes

Bubba Watson (T2/-8)

- Offset one bogey with five birdies for a 4-under 66; marks third time in TOUR career to start a tournament with back-to-back rounds of 66 or better (2010 The American Express/T2, 2014 Waste Management Phoenix Open/T2)
- Sank 115'3" of putts, highlighted by a 50' birdie putt on No. 7; marks sixth round this season making over 100 feet of putts in one round (most since 2016-17 season)
- Hit 29 greens in regulation in first 36 holes at TPC River Highlands for the fourth time (2013, 2015, 2020)
- Played Nos. 4-7 at 4-under this week; marks third time at Travelers Championship to play that stretch in 4-under or better in the first two rounds (2008/-5, 2009/-4)
- Seeks fourth win at this event (2013, 2015, 2018) and, like Jason Day, his 13th career win on TOUR

Additional Notes

- Kramer Hickok (T2/-8) hit 13 of 14 fairways and 13 of 18 greens in regulation to finish 1-under 69; remains in search of his first career TOUR victory in his 68th start; T8 at the 2020 Bermuda Championship earlier this season stands as his best finish
- **Justin Rose** (T4/-7) offset one bogey with eight birdies en route to a 7-under 63, marking his third round of 63 or better in 10 Travelers Championship starts; his eight birdies also ties his most in a round at TPC River Highlands (R2/2010)
- In his fifth start at the Travelers Championship, **Kevin Kisner** (T4/-7) notched six birdies and one eagle en route to 7-under 63 and leads the field in Strokes Gained: Putting (4.193) in the second round after sitting 113th in SG: Putting in the opening round
- Beginning on No. 10, **K.H. Lee** (T4/-7) made eagle on the par-5 13th hole and par-4 15th hole en route to an outgoing 29; marks first time in his career with multiple eagles in a round on TOUR and lowest 9-hole score in his TOUR career
- Following missed cuts in his three most recent Travelers Championship starts (2018, 2019 and 2020) **Brice Garnett** (T4/-7) started his round with three consecutive birdies (Nos. 10-12) for the second time in his TOUR career (2018 AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am/R3)
- Defending Travelers Championship winner Dustin Johnson sits T58 after 2-under 68
- Kevin Na (T48/-3) made his 300th cut on TOUR
- Three of the four Monday Qualifiers advanced to the weekend (Seamus Power/-7, Lucas Herbert/-3, Andrew Svoboda/-2, Scott Stallings, Jr./MC)
