



## 2021 Travelers Championship Broadcast Window & Pre-Tournament Notes



- 82.14%** Patrick Reed has the highest percentage of rounds better than the field this season at 82.14% (*min 34 rds*) and is on pace for his best percentage in a single season of his TOUR career
  
- 11<sup>th</sup>** Currently 11<sup>th</sup> in the FedExCup standings with two wins this season (Fortinet Championship & RBC Heritage), Stewart Cink is the fourth oldest player in the Top 125 of the FedExCup (*average age of Top 125: 33.2*)
  
- 3** Bryson DeChambeau has the longest active streak of top 10s at the Travelers Championship since 1987
  
- 8** Currently 83<sup>rd</sup> in the FedExCup standings, Garrick Higgo is one of eight players under 25 currently ranked inside the top 125 of the FedExCup (*average age of Top 125: 33.2*)
  
- 30' 2"** Marc Leishman has ranked inside the top 20 in Approaches from 175-200 yards in each of the last three seasons, joining Charley Hoffman as the only two players ranking 20<sup>th</sup> or better in this stat each season since 2018-19. Leishman averages 30' 2" in proximity to the hole from the approaches shots since the 2018-19 season.
  
- 31** Patrick Cantlay is 31-under par and has three top-15 finishes in last three starts at Travelers Championship
  
- 68** Paul Casey is 68-under par in his Travelers Championship career, best of any player since 2015 and his best at any TOUR event

### Past Champions Analysis

- 9** Dustin Johnson came from nine strokes back after 18 holes to win the 2020 Travelers Championship, marking the largest come-from-behind victory after 18 holes at this event since 1984
- 4** Four of the last five winners at TPC River Highlands have ranked inside the top-seven in SG: Approach-the-Green en route to victory
- 5' 6"** Since 2016, winners at TPC River Highlands are 5' 6" better than the field average on approaches from 150-175 yards. Winners average 21' 1" in proximity to the hole on these approach shots while the field average is 26' 7".
- 8** Since 2012, eight of the last nine Travelers Championship winners ranked inside the top 10 in SG: Tee-to-Green en route to victory at TPC River Highlands
- 3** Three of the last seven winners at the Travelers Championship have played the final four holes in six under or better (*2014 Kevin Streelman/-7, 2019 Chez Reavie/-6 & 2017 Jordan Spieth/-6*)
