

Dustin Johnson

Dustin Johnson is set to make his fourth start at the Valspar Championship with his best finish coming in his most recent start at this event (T6/2019). Dustin currently ranks 10th in the Comcast Business TOUR Top 10 with one win (2020 Masters), four top 10s and six top-25 finishes this season.
