Rory McIlroy

Two-time Wells Fargo champion (2010 & 2015) and two-time FedExCup champion (2016 & 2019) Rory McIlroy is set to make his 10th start at the Wells Fargo Championship. McIlroy has eight top-20 finishes in nine previous starts at this event *(including seven consecutive top 20s entering this week)*.

Fast Facts on Rory McIlroy:

- 69.71** Rory McIlroy has the lowest scoring average at Quail Hollow Club (69.71) of any player with 12 or more rounds *(including 2017 PGA Championship)*
- 7** has the longest active streak of top-20 finishes at the Wells Fargo Championship of any player (7)

2017 FedExCup champion Justin Thomas moved to No. 1 in the FedExCup for the 42nd time in his PGA TOUR career with a T13 finish at last week's Valspar Championship. Thomas is one of three players (Cameron Smith & Hideki Matsuyama) who are currently inside the Comcast Business TOUR Top 10 and were inside the Comcast Business TOUR Top 10 with 13 weeks left in the FedExCup regular season last season.

Fast Facts on Justin Thomas:

- 42** Total weeks ranked No. 1 in the FedExCup, fourth-most of any player in the FedExCup era
- 8** Won the 2017 PGA Championship at Quail Hollow Club at eight-under par for his first major championship victory
