Extended Forecast – Drier and cooler air will return Wednesday night into Thursday before another piece of energy moves through the region Friday. This could produce some isolated showers as it passes overhead. But the higher chances will likely be to the north of Charlotte. Otherwise, partly cloudy skies can be expected with highs around 70 degrees. After a cold start Saturday morning, temperatures will rebound back into the mid 70s with warmer temperatures returning Sunday with highs in the low 80s. The next weather system will arrive Monday with another round of showers and thunderstorms.
