- Max Homa moved up 69 positions in the FedExCup standings with his victory at the 2021 Genesis Invitational (moved from 79th to 10th), marking the biggest move in the FedExCup last week
- Total players in this week's WGC-Workday Championship at The Concession who can overtake Patrick Cantlay for the No.1 position in the FedExCup with a victory
- **2,399** Dustin Johnson has earned 2,399 FedExCup points at the WGC-Workday Championship at The Concession, most of any player since 2009

Patrick Reed

Defending and two-time (2014) WGC-Workday Championship at The Concession champion Patrick Reed is set to make his eighth start at this event.

Fast Facts on Patrick Reed:

5 th	With his victory at this event last season, Patrick Reed became the fifth multiple winner of the
	event and the 15 th player to win multiple World Golf Championships.

One of three players who have qualified for the TOUR Championship in each of the last seven PGA TOUR seasons (*Dustin Johnson & Hideki Matsuyama*).

1st Had a career week on the greens at this event last season, outperforming the field by +2.96 strokes per round in Strokes Gained: Putting.

Since the start of the 2013 PGA TOUR season, Patrick Reed has ranked sixth or better in Scrambling 32 times in an event, most of any player in this time frame. When ranking 6th or better in Scrambling, Patrick Reed has finished inside the top 10 for the event 63% of the time (20 of 32).

Bryson DeChambeau

Bryson DeChambeau is set to make his third start at the WGC-Workday Championship at The Concession.

Fast Facts on Bryson DeChambeau:

- Shot 131 (68-63) in the opening two rounds at this event last season, one of six TOUR events where Bryson has shot 131 or better in the opening 36-holes.
- Leads the PGA TOUR this season in Strokes Gained: Tee-to-Green, Strokes Gained: Off-the-Tee, Driving Distance, Driving Distance (All Drives) and Club Head Speed. DeChambeau has hit 51% of his drives over 320 yards, marking the highest percentage of drives 320+ of any player this season and over 12% more than the next best player.
- Bryson DeChambeau has spent 18 of 19 weeks ranked inside the top 15 of the FedExCup, only Stewart Cink has spent all 19 weeks inside the top 15 of the standings. DeChambeau currently ranks 11th in the FedExCup.

Viktor Hovland is set to make his tournament debut at the WGC-Workday Championship at The Concession and his 39th career start on the PGA TOUR. Hovland is one of four players currently 25 and younger with multiple TOUR wins (Collin Morikawa/3/24, Si Woo Kim/3/25 and Cameron Champ/2/25).

Fast Facts on Viktor Hovland:

- Hovland has four top-five finishes when making his tournament debut on the PGA TOUR.

 Hovland won the 2020 Puerto Rico Open for his first TOUR win and finished T5 in his first start at last week's The Genesis Invitational.
- Viktor Hovland has played his last 29 holes without a bogey, marking the longest active bogey-free streak of any player this season.

Jon Rahm is set to make his fifth start at the WGC-Workday Championship at The Concession. Rahm currently ranks 13th in the FedExCup standings and is one of 14 players who can move to No. 1 in the FedExCup with a win at the WGC-Workday Championship at The Concession.

Fast Fact on Jon Rahm:

- 3 Has three top-20 finishes in four previous starts at this event (T3/2017 & 2020, T20/2018)
- Jon Rahm has shot under par in each of his eight opening rounds on TOUR this season. Jon Rahm on average is 20th on the leaderboard after the opening round this season, fourth best average after Round 1 position this season *(min 6 starts)*.

Hideki Matsuyama is set to make his seventh start at the WGC-Workday Championship at The Concession.

Fast Facts on Hideki Matsuyama:

Longest active streak of consecutive holes without a three-putt on TOUR and is his second longest streak without a three putt in his PGA TOUR career (longest streak: 182)

+197.44 Since the start of the 2016-17 PGA TOUR season, Hideki Matsuyama has gained 197.44 total strokes on his approach play, only Justin Thomas (+233.88) has gained more in Strokes Gained: Approach-the-Green in this time frame.

Tony Finau

Tony Finau is set to make his third start at the WGC-Workday Championship at The Concession. Finau is coming off his eighth career runner-up finish on the PGA TOUR after losing to Max Homa in a playoff last week at The Genesis Invitational.

Fast Facts on Tony Finau:

Tony Finau has 37 top-10 finishes on TOUR since the start of the 2016-17 season, most of any player without a win in this time frame. Finau has the most runner-up finishes (8), top-fives (21),

top 10s (37) and top 25s (60) of any player without a win in this stretch.

1st Led the field last week at Riviera CC in Strokes Gained: Tee-to-Green. Finau outperformed the field by +2.59 strokes per round from tee to green. It was the eighth time in Finau's PGA TOUR career to rank First in this category.

Rory McIlroy

Rory McIlroy is set to make his 12th start at the WGC-Workday Championship at The Concession with eight top-10s in 11 previous starts.

Fast Facts on Rory McIlroy:

- 8 Total top 10s at this event, most in any PGA TOUR event of Rory McIlroy's career
- -186 Rory McIlroy is 23 strokes better than any other player in WGC events since 2009. In this time frame, Rory McIlroy is 186-under par and has 19 rounds of five under or better in WGC stroke-play events.
- **76.9%** Percentage of rounds in WGC stroke play events where Rory McIlroy has been better than the field average since 2009 (80 of 104). This is the highest percentage of rounds better than the field average in WGC events since 2009 (min 14 rds)
- **1,434** Rory McIlroy has earned the most FedExCup points in Florida over the last four seasons (1,434)
- McIlroy has been inside the top-five of the leaderboard after 12 rounds in Florida, most of any player in the last four PGA TOUR seasons.

2017 FedExCup champion Justin Thomas is set to make his sixth start at the WGC-Workday Championship at The Concession.

- Justin Thomas has the most rounds of 67 or better at this event of any player since 2016 (10)

Max Homa

Two-time PGA TOUR winner and last week's winner at The Genesis Invitational Max Homa is set to make his tournament debut at the WGC-Workday Championship at The Concession. Since 1999, Phil Mickelson (2009) and Dustin Johnson (2017) are the only players to win The Genesis Invitational and then this event in the same season.

Fast Facts on Max Homa:

10 th	Currently ranks 10 th in the FedExCup standings, marking his highest FedExCup rank of his TOUR
	career. Homa has earned 641 FedExCup points in his last three starts, only Dustin Johnson has

- Started last week with 11 consecutive one putts at Riviera CC, marking the longest streak of consecutive one putts to start an event by a TOUR winner in the ShotLink era
