**Championship Match:** Billy Horschel (32) defeats Scottie Scheffler (30), 2 and 1

**Consolation Match:** Matt Kuchar (52) defeats Victor Perez (31), 2 and 1

**Things to Know**

- Billy Horschel defeats Scottie Scheffler in the Championship Match, 2 and 1, earning his sixth career PGA TOUR victory and first individual title since the 2017 AT&T Byron Nelson in Dallas
- Horschel has a win and runner-up in the first two World Golf Championships events of the season (T2/WGC-Workday Championship at The Concession); Scottie Scheffler also finished in the top five at both events
- Scheffler’s runner-up marks his career-best finish on TOUR
- With his victory in the Consolation Match, 2013 champion Matt Kuchar collects his 34<sup>th</sup> match win, draws to within two of Tiger Woods’ tournament record

**CHAMPIONSHIP MATCH NOTES**

**Billy Horschel**

- Took a 1-up lead against Scottie Scheffler after No. 7 and did not lose the lead for the remainder of the match; closed the 2-and-1 victory with a par on No. 17
- Claims his sixth career PGA TOUR victory in his 266<sup>th</sup> start at the age of 34 years, 3 months, 21 days
- Most recent individual title came at the 2017 AT&T Byron Nelson in Dallas; in 2018, won the Zurich Classic of New Orleans with Scott Piercy as partner

- Wins in his fifth start in the World Golf Championships-Dell Technologies Match Play; had never previously advanced to the Round of 16
- Wins in his 20<sup>th</sup> World Golf Championships start; most recently finished T2 in the season's first WGC event (WGC-Workday Championship at The Concession)
- With the win, the 2014 FedExCup champion collects 550 FedExCup points and moves from 45<sup>th</sup> to No. 7 in the standings
- With the win, becomes fully exempt on the PGA TOUR through the 2023-24 season
- Win marks his fourth top-10 finish in his 13<sup>th</sup> start of the season and is his first since a T2 at the WGC-Workday Championship at The Concession

#### Scottie Scheffler

- 2018 University of Texas alum's only loss of the week came in the Championship Match against Billy Horschel
- Claims his career-best PGA TOUR finish in his 48<sup>th</sup> start (previous: solo-third, 2020 The American Express)
- Runner-up finish comes in his fourth World Golf Championships appearance (previous-best finish: 5<sup>th</sup>/2021 WGC-Workday Championship at The Concession)
- With his Semifinals win, joined Jon Rahm as players to advance to the Championship Match in their tournament debut since Austin Country Club began hosting the event in 2016; Rahm lost to Dustin Johnson in 2017
- Third top-10 his in last five starts; T7/Waste Management Phoenix Open, 5<sup>th</sup>/WGC-Workday Championship at The Concession, 2<sup>nd</sup>/WGC-Dell Technologies Match Play

#### CONSOLATION MATCH NOTES

##### **Matt Kuchar**

- 2013 champion and 2019 runner-up never trailed in his 2-and-1 victory over France's Victor Perez
- Collects his 34<sup>th</sup> match win at the event, second-most in tournament history (most: Tiger Woods, 36)
- This week marked his fourth berth in the Round of 16 in his last five starts in the event

##### **Victor Perez**

- Earned his best result in his fifth World Golf Championships appearance; previous-best result: T4/2019 WGC-HSBC Champions
- 13<sup>th</sup> career start on the PGA TOUR and first since a T9 at THE PLAYERS Championship
- Second player from France in tournament history to advance to the Semifinals (Victor Dubuisson/2014/2<sup>nd</sup>); no player from France has won a World Golf Championships event
- Winner of the 2019 Alfred Dunhill Links Championship on the European Tour
