Things to Know

- Tommy Fleetwood makes a hole-in-one from 179 yards on the par-3 fourth hole and advances to the Quarterfinals for the first time since the event moved to Austin Country Club
- Former University of Texas standout Scottie Scheffler advances to the Quarterfinals in his tournament debut with a 5-and-4 win over 2010 champion Ian Poulter
- Sergio Garcia advances to the Quarterfinals for the second consecutive time at Austin Country Club, with his win over Mackenzie Hughes, 2 and 1
- As the only top seed in group play to advance to the Round of 16, Jon Rahm advances to the Quarterfinals for the second time at Austin Country Club
- After being 4-down through six holes, Brian Harman wins seven consecutive holes to secure his first trip to the Quarterfinals in a 2-and-1 win over 2018 champion Bubba Watson
- Matt Kuchar, the 2019 runner-up, defeats Jordan Spieth and advances to the Quarterfinals for the second consecutive year at Austin Country Club

- Tommy Fleetwood closed out the match with a birdie on No. 15 to win 4-up over former Texas Longhorn Frittelli

- Advances to the Quarterfinals for the first time since the event moved to Austin Country Club in 2016. Previous best finish was in 2015 at Harding Park where he fell to Danny Willett, 4 and 3 in the Quarterfinals
- Fleetwood made a hole-in-one from 179 yards on the par-3 fourth hole with a 7-iron

- Horschel won his opening two holes and never trailed en-route to a 3-and-1 win over Kevin Streelman
- Horschel advances to the Quarterfinals for the first time in four tournament appearances since the group play format was introduced in 2016
- 2014 FedExCup champion finished T2 in the season's first World Golf Championships event at the WGC-Workday Championship at The Concession; seeks his first WGC title in his 20th career start

- Sergio Garcia was 1-down to Canada's Mackenzie Hughes through six holes but rallied for a 2-and-1 win
- Garcia advances to the Quarterfinals for the third time in 18 tournament appearances
- Experienced his best finish at Austin Country Club in 2019 where he advanced to the Quarterfinals before falling to Matt Kuchar, 2-up
- Garcia is in search of his first World Golf Championships title in his 64th appearance

- Victor Perez won holes 10-12 to take a 6-up lead through 12 holes over Robert MacIntyre before settling for a 5-and-4 victory; secured advancement to the Quarterfinals in his first appearance at the WGC-Dell Technologies Match Play
- The European Tour winner is making his fifth World Golf Championships appearance this week (best finish T4/2019 WGC-HSBC Champions)
- No player from France has won a World Golf Championships event

- Scottie Scheffler won his first hole on No. 3 and never trailed en route to a 5-and 4-win over 2010 WGC-Dell Technologies Match Play winner Ian Poulter, who did not win a hole in the Round of 16
- The University of Texas graduate will advance to the Quarterfinals against Jon Rahm in his tournament debut
- In 13 starts during the 2021-21 season, Scheffler owns two top-10s, including a solo fifth at the WGC-Workday Championship at The Concession

- As the only top seed in group play to advance to the Round of 16, Jon Rahm advances to the Quarterfinals for the second time at Austin Country Club
- Rahm will meet former Texas Longhorn Scottie Scheffler in the Quarterfinals
- His best finish at the WGC-Dell Technologies Match Play was in 2017 when he advanced to the Championship Match, ultimately falling short to Dustin Johnson, 1-up

- After being 4-down through six holes, Brian Harman won seven consecutive holes to secure his first trip to the Quarterfinals in a 2-and-1 win over 2018 champion Bubba Watson
- In his previous best finish at the WGC-Dell Technologies Match Play, Harman went head-to-head against Watson in the Round of 16 in 2018 but ultimately fell short, 2 and 1
- Harman qualified for the WGC-Dell Technologies Match Play following a T3 finish at THE PLAYERS Championship

- Matt Kuchar birdies the 18th hole to defeat Jordan Spieth, 1-up, after being 2-down through 10 holes
- Kuchar, the 2019 runner-up, advances to the Quarterfinals for the second consecutive year at Austin Country Club
- With the win, improves his overall record to 14-4-4 at Austin Country Club

- Kuchar is in search of his 10th PGA TOUR title and first since the 2019 Sony Open in Hawaii
