TOURNAMENT STORYLINES

Strong field: 48 of the top 50 players in the Official World Golf Ranking are in the field at the World Golf Championships-FedEx St. Jude Invitational, including nine of the top 10. Only the (2021) Masters Tournament, PGA Championship and (2021) U.S. Open have had more top 50 players in the field during the 2020-21 season.

Top players winning five years in a row: In each of the last five years (including three prior to the move to TPC Southwind), the winner of the WGC-FedEx St. Jude Invitational has entered the week in the top three of both the FedExCup standings and the Official World Golf Ranking. Collin Morikawa (No. 1 FEC, No. 3 OWGR) is the only player in the field that can extend the streak to six.

Bubble watch: Three players in the field are between Nos. 120-135 in the FedExCup standings with just two weeks remaining in the Regular Season: Adam Scott (123), Tommy Fleetwood (133) and Justin Rose (134). Scott and Rose are among the nine players that have qualified for the FedExCup Playoffs in each season since the inception of the FedExCup in 2007.

FedExCup Playoffs come to TPC Southwind in 2022: On Tuesday, August 3, as part of the release of the 2021-22 PGA TOUR Schedule, it was announced that the first FedExCup Playoffs event is moving to TPC Southwind and will be called the FedEx St. Jude Championship. Other highlights of the schedule announcement include the PGA TOUR and European Tour co-sanctioning three events in 2022 (Genesis Scottish Open, Barbasol Championship and Barracuda Championship).

High score wins: Since 2012, the Barracuda Championship has been played using Modified Stableford scoring. The Modified Stableford scoring system allocates points based on the number of strokes taken at each hole, with the goal of achieving the highest overall number of points:

FedExCup Push: The Barracuda Championship, offering 300 FedExCup points to the winner, is one of three events remaining in the 2020-21 PGA TOUR Regular Season. The field includes three of the nine players who have qualified for the FedExCup Playoffs in every season since inception of the FedExCup (2007-present) – Brandt Snedeker (No. 91), Matt Kuchar (No. 120) and Ryan Moore (No. 140), as well as 20 of the 25 players between Nos. 126-150 in the standings.

Tokyo to Truckee: Three Olympians will be traveling to the Barracuda Championship following the Olympic men's golf competition: Mito Pereira, Chile (T4); Thomas Pieters, Belgium (T16); and Rafael Campos, Puerto Rico (T57).

First win feeling: The last five winners of the Barracuda Championship were first-time PGA TOUR winners, the longest active streak on TOUR (2020/Richy Werenski, 2019/Collin Morikawa, 2018/Andrew Putnam, 2017/Chris Stroud, 2016/Greg Chalmers).

MEMBERSHIP STORYLINE: TOMMY FLEETWOOD

Tommy Fleetwood is the only PGA TOUR member in the field that has not secured full-time membership for the 2021-22 season. Fleetwood enters the week No. 133 in the FedExCup standings and trails No. 125 Rickie Fowler by 34.14 points (roughly a two-way T28 this week).

If Fleetwood is inside the top 125 after the Wyndham Championship, he qualifies for the FedExCup Playoffs and secures his PGA TOUR card for the 2021-22 season.

If he his between Nos. 126-150 after the Wyndham Championship, he will have limited status on TOUR in 2021-22 (category: 126-150 on Prior Season's FedExCup Points List) and be eligible for 2021 Korn Ferry Tour Finals.

OPEN QUALIFIER SPOTLIGHT

The Barracuda Championship open qualifier at Hidden Valley Country Club ended in a two-person playoff that saw 37-year-old Mark Baldwin qualify for the final spot defeating Justin Warren. Justin Suh and John Greco tied for medalist after shooting 63 (-8). Suh posted a bogey-free round while Greco made eight birdies and one eagle. Akshay Bhatia took the third qualifying spot after posting a bogey-free 64 (-8).

This is the second time that Suh and Bhatia have advanced through an open qualifier. Suh did so for the first time at the 2021 Rocket Mortgage Classic (MC), while Bhatia finished T52 at the World Wide Technology Championship at Mayakoba earlier this season as an open qualifier.

Baldwin has made it through as an open qualifier twice before: 2014 Shriners Children's Open (MC) and 2019 3M Open (MC).
