



Past Champions Analysis

- **-1.88**Justin Thomas lost 1.88 total strokes on the greens en route to victory at the 2020 WGC-FedEx St. Jude Invitational, marking the sixth lowest SG: Putting total by a TOUR winner since 2004
- In 2019, Brooks Koepka joined Tiger Woods (Eight times) Geoff Ogilvy, Rory McIlroy, and Dustin Johnson as the only players to win a major and a World Golf Championships event in the same season since 1999. Collin Morikawa later joined these players after victories at the WGC-Workday Championship at The Concession and The Open Championship in 2021.
- **Bogey-Free** Brooks Koepka went bogey-free en route to a final round 65, marked the first winner at the WGC-FedEx St. Jude Invitational since Hideki Matsuyama (2017)
- **90.91%**Brooks Koepka managed to salvage par 90.91% of the time when missing the greens in regulation en route to victory at TPC Southwind in 2019, marked the best Scrambling performance by a winner of the WGC-FedEx St. Jude Invitational and the third winner with over a 90% performance at TPC Southwind in the last 28 years
- **96' 5"**Brooks Koepka averaged 96' 5" of putts made en route to victory at TPC Southwind, marked the fourth longest average of putts made by a winner of the WGC-FedEx St. Jude Invitational and the fifth longest average of any winner at TPC Southwind in the ShotLink era
- Brooks Koepka made 63 of 65 putts from inside 10 feet (96.92%), marked the second-best Putting Inside 10 Feet performance by a winner of the WGC-FedEx St. Jude Invitational in the ShotLink era
- Seven of the last nine winners at TPC Southwind led the field in Strokes Gained: Tee-to-Green en route to victory at this course. The last nine winners were better than the field from tee to green in 35 of their 36 combined rounds in this stretch.
