Temperatures will be warm today with highs in the upper 80s with slightly higher humidity.

Extended Forecast – The heat and humidity ramps up this weekend pushing the heat index values into the mid to upper 90s Saturday and around 100F Sunday. A few thunderstorms will be possible Monday afternoon with highs in the mid 90s with the heat index making it feel more like 103-105F during the afternoon.
