- 14** Jim Herman (2020) made 14 putts over 10 feet en route to victory at Sedgefield CC last season, marking the most by a Wyndham Championship winner at this course
- Bogey-free** J.T. Poston (2019) became the first player since Lee Trevino (1974 Zurich Classic) to win on the PGA TOUR without making a bogey (four round event)
- 52 of 52** J.T. Poston (2019) made every putt from inside five feet (52 of 52), joined Henrik Stenson (2017), Patrick Reed (2013), Webb Simpson (2011) and Ryan Moore (2009) as the only winners at Sedgefield CC to make every putt from inside five feet in the last 12 years

- 5** Five of the 14 winners at the Wyndham Championship have qualified for the TOUR Championship. 2011 champion Webb Simpson finishing second in the final FedExCup standings, marking the best FedExCup finish by a winner at the Wyndham Championship.
- 1,747** Webb Simpson has earned the most FedExCup points of any player at the Wyndham Championship since 2009 (1,747)
- 2** Since 2009, Webb Simpson (2011, 2018 & 2019) and Jordan Spieth are the only players who have played their way into the Comcast Business TOUR TOP 10 in the last week of the regular season
- 10** 10 of 29 Players who qualified for the FedExCup Playoffs were ranked 134<sup>th</sup> or worse at Wyndham Championship and played their way into the FedExCup Playoffs (Since 2009)
