



# **Past Champions Analysis**

- **14** Jim Herman (2020) made 14 putts over 10 feet en route to victory at Sedgefield CC last season, marking the most by a Wyndham Championship winner at this course
- **Bogey-free** J.T. Poston (2019) became the first player since Lee Trevino (1974 Zurich Classic) to win on the PGA TOUR without making a bogey (four round event)
- **52 of 52** J.T. Poston (2019) made every putt from inside five feet (52 of 52), joined Henrik Stenson (2017), Patrick Reed (2013), Webb Simpson (2011) and Ryan Moore (2009) as the only winners at Sedgefield CC to make every putt from inside five feet in the last 12 years
- **62 / 63** Each of the last two winners of this event have shot 63 or better in the Final Round en route to victory, the only TOUR event with an active streak where the last two winners have posted Final Rounds of 63 or better (2020 Jim Herman/63, 2019 J.T. Poston/62)
- **+2.291** Si Woo Kim (2016) outperformed the field by +2.291 strokes per round on approach shots. Eight of the last 12 winners of the Wyndham Championship have ranked inside the top 10 in Strokes Gained: Approach-the-Green en route to victory
- **87.5%** Jim Herman (2020) and Henrik Stenson (2017) both hit 87.5% of the greens in regulation, marking the best Greens in Regulation percentage by a Wyndham Championship winner at Sedgefield CC
- 7 Henrik Stenson's (2017) seven putts made from outside 20 feet, marked the most putts made outside 20' by a winner at Sedgefield CC since 2008
