









Wyndham Championship

Extended Forecast – An approaching cold front will bring increasing chances for showers and thunderstorms Saturday afternoon with rain and thunderstorms becoming likely during the evening hours. Storms could be strong with gusty wind and heavy rainfall. The front is expected to settle into North Carolina on Sunday and begin to interact with the remnants of Tropical Storm Fred. Showers will be possible Sunday morning with showers and thunderstorms becoming likely during the afternoon. Showers and the chance for thunderstorms will continue into Monday as Fred lifts further norward. Rainfall could be heavy at times, especially with thunderstorms.
