**Sunday's Forecast** – A cold front will stall across North Carolina while Tropical Storm Fred moves towards the Florida Panhandle. Tropical moisture combining with the front will act as a focus for numerous showers and thunderstorms, especially during the afternoon into the evening hours. Rainfall could be heavy at times with gusty winds possible with the storms. Otherwise, it will not be as hot with cloud cover holding temperatures in the low 80s. Rainfall will average 0.50-1.00" by the end of the day.
