Scattered showers and thunderstorms will be possible during the late afternoon before dissipating later this evening. A southwest breeze of 4-8 mph will provide little relief from the heat today.

Extended Forecast – High pressure off-shore will continue to provide hot and humid conditions over the region Friday with highs in the low 90s. Heat index values will make it feel more like 99-102F during the afternoon hours. Scattered showers and thunderstorms will be possible as we reach the peak heating of the day. An approaching cold front will bring increasing chances for showers and thunderstorms Saturday afternoon and continue into Sunday as the front settles over the state. The remnants of Tropical Storm Fred may move far enough norward to keep rain and storms in the forecast Monday into early next week.
