**Things to Know**

- Seeking his 14<sup>th</sup> PGA TOUR victory, Justin Thomas holds the 36-hole lead/co-lead for the 11<sup>th</sup> time in his PGA TOUR career
- Dylan Frittelli carded eight birdies in the second round, moving up two positions on the leaderboard from T4 to 2<sup>nd</sup>
- Lanto Griffin’s 36-hole score marks the lowest of his PGA TOUR career
- Tiger Woods is T66 after carding a 6-under 66 in response to his opening-round 76; ties the largest improvement between R1 and R2 in his PGA TOUR career
- Recording 12 birdies, Richy Werenski (T6) broke his career record for most birdies in a round on the PGA TOUR by three (9/2020 3M Open) and ties the course record at Sherwood (61)
- With 18 bogey-free rounds, the R2 scoring average of 67.87 sets a new record for low scoring average at Sherwood Country Club; previously 69.27 (2002 Hero World Challenge)

- Matched his opening-round 65 totaling a 36-hole score of 130 en route to holding his 11<sup>th</sup> 36-hole lead/co-lead; he has converted six of those instances into victories (most recent: 2019 THE CJ CUP @ NINE BRIDGES)
- Has won 4 of 7 events when shooting 130 or better through opening 36 holes of a PGA TOUR event

- The World No. 3 is one of 18 players to record a bogey-free second round
- In his last 27 holes he is 14-under, including a cumulative 12-under on the back nine
- Has finished inside the top 12 in both of his starts of the 2020-21 season (T8/U.S. Open, T12/THE CJ CUP @ SHADOW CREEK)
- Second start at the ZOZO CHAMPIONSHIP (T17/2019) and finished 2<sup>nd</sup> in the 2019-20 FedExCup standings

**Dylan Frittelli (T2/-13)**

- Carding a second-round 65, Frittelli ties his low 36-hole score of 131 (2020 Shriners Hospitals for Children Open)
- Through 36 holes he is ranked first in Driving Distance (294.9 yards)
- His best 36-hole finish was at the 2019 Safeway Open (T3); went on to finish T7; best career position after 36 holes; finished T7 at 2019 Safeway Open after sitting T3 through two rounds
- Fourth start of the season (MC/Sanderson Farms Championship, T34/Shriners Hospitals for Children Open, T69/THE CJ CUP @ SHADOW CREEK)
- Earned first PGA TOUR win at the 2019 John Deere Classic. He was T11 following R2
- Second start at the ZOZO CHAMPIONSHIP (2019/T22); finished 57<sup>th</sup> in the 2019-20 FedExCup standings to qualify for the event.

**Lanto Griffin (T2/-13)**

- 36-hole 131 sets a career low for the Blacksburg, Virginia native. His previous career low was 132 (2019 Shriners Hospitals for Children Open, 2019 A Military Tribute at The Greenbrier)
- Hit 14 of 18 greens in regulation and was second in Strokes Gained: Approach the Green (+3.143) in round two
- Seeking his second career PGA TOUR victory (2019 Houston Open)
- Has made three starts in the 2020-21 season and is coming off a T7 finish at THE CJ CUP @ SHADOW CREEK
- Finished 18<sup>th</sup> in the final 2019-20 FedExCup standings and qualified for the TOUR Championship in his second full season on TOUR

**Patrick Cantlay (T4/-12)**

- Bogey-free through opening 36 holes for the first time in his career
- Finished the 2019-20 season ranked No. 36 in the FedExCup standings, qualifying him for his ZOZO CHAMPIONSHIP @ SHERWOOD debut this week
- Owns one top-10 in three starts in the 2020-21 season (Shriners/T8)
- Owns two PGA TOUR victories (2017) Shriners Hospitals for Children Open (2019) the Memorial Tournament presented by Nationwide.

**Tiger Woods (T66/-2)**

- Today's round ties his biggest improvement between R1 and R2 in his PGA TOUR career

- Hit 10 of 13 fairways in regulation, compared to just seven in round one

- First sub-70 round since 2020 THE NORTHERN TRUST (66/R4)
- Second start of the 2020-21 season (MC/U.S. Open)
- Won the Hero World Challenge, an unofficial PGA TOUR event, five times at Sherwood Country Club (2001, 2004, 2006, 2007, 2011)

#### Additional Player Notes

- For the first time in his career, **Abraham Ancer** (T6/-11) carded two consecutive bogey-free rounds
- **Scottie Scheffler** (T4/-12) opened his round with five consecutive birdies en route to a second-round 65
- **Harris English** (T6/-11) seeks his third career victory and first since the 2013 Mayakoba Golf Classic
- **Bubba Watson** (T6/-11) carded 9-under 63 in the second round, highlighted by eight birdies and an eagle
- Coming off an opening-round 64, 18-hole leader **Sebastian Munoz** carded a second-round 70 and is T14
- **Jordan Spieth** (T27/-8) went bogey free in round-two for the first time since 2019 THE NORTHERN TRUST (R1)
