Today – Overcast skies this morning with a slim threat for light drizzle, but no accumulation will occur. There could be some thinning of the cloud layer aloft to allow for some peaks of sun later this afternoon. Temperatures will slowly warm into the upper 60s, while temperatures will fall back into the mid to upper 50s overnight. Light southeasterly winds will turn southwesterly and increase in speed this afternoon.

Extended forecast – The marine layer will deepen further this weekend as an upper trough digs into the Great Basin and a weak upper low traverses coastal southern California. Expect overcast to mostly cloudy skies, areas of drizzle, and perhaps some light rain through the weekend – with the greatest precipitation chances occurring during the overnight and morning hours each day. Temperatures will start out in the mid-50s each morning and will warm into the mid-60s. A few showers may linger into Monday morning before the upper trough moves through the area and Santa Ana winds become gusty in its wake through Monday evening.
